1. (U) THE UNHRC SPECIAL RAPPORTEUR ON SUMMARY AND ARBITRARY EXECUTIONS, BACRE WALY NDIAYE, ARRIVED IN LIMA MAY 23 AND BEGAN MEETINGS MAY 24. DURING HIS NINE-DAY VISIT, NDIAYE WILL MEET WITH GOVERNMENT MINISTERS, HUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS, FAMILY MEMBERS OF VICTIMS OF DISAPPEARANCES AND EXTRAJUDICIAL EXECUTIONS, AND VARIOUS OTHER INDIVIDUALS. NDIAYE WILL TRAVEL TO HUANUCO, TARAPOTO AND AYACUCO DURING HIS VISIT. HE IS ACCOMPANIED BY SEVERAL ASSISTANTS.

2. (U) THE LOCAL U.N. DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

OFFICE, WHICH IS SUPPORTING THE VISIT, TOLD US THAT THE MISSION HAS NOT RECEIVED NEARLY AS MUCH ATTENTION AS THE MAY 16-21 VISIT BY THE INTER-AMERICAN HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION. UNDP OFFICIALS WERE CONCERNED THAT TOO MUCH PRESS COVERAGE COULD BE DISTRACTING.

3. (C) WE UNDERSTAND FROM THE LEGAL DEFENSE INSTITUTE THAT NDIAYE HAS DECIDED NOT TO EXAMINE A RECENTLY-DISCOVERED BONE PIT THAT MAY CONTAIN THE REMAINS OF EXECUTED INDIVIDUALS (REF B). WE HAVE HEARD, HOWEVER, THAT NDIAYE PLANS TO LOOK CLOSELY AT THREE OF THE MOST WELL-KNOWN HUMAN RIGHTS CASES: THE NOVEMBER 1991 BARRIOS ALTOS MASSACRE, THE JULY 1992 LA CANTUTA
