- THE FOOD SITUATION IN NORTH KOREA CONTINUES TO BE Α. VERY SERIOUS AND WE ARE MONITORING IT CLOSELY. THE WORLD FOOD PROGRAM (WFP) AND THE FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANIZATION (FAO) ISSUED A NEW REPORT ON DECEMBER 6, WHICH PROJECTS THIS YEAR'S FOOD SHORTFALL TO BE LARGER THAN A YEAR AGO. THIS SHORTFALL COULD FURTHER AGGRAVATE THE ALREADY WEAKENED NUTRITIONAL STATE OF THE NORTH KOREAN CIVILAINS.
