





UNIVERSITY, ON THE EASTERN OUTSKIRTS OF LIMA. JOURNALISTS HAD PREVIOUSLY BUSSED TO CHOSICA IN MAY TO OBSERVE AN INSPECTION OF THE CAMPUS (REF A). THIS TIME THE INVESTIGATORS WANTED TO SEE THE UNIVERSITY AT NIGHT, SINCE THE ABDUCTIONS THERE ON JULY 18, 1992, OF NINE STUDENTS AND A PROFESSOR OCCURRED JUST AFTER MIDNIGHT. THE INVESTIGATORS ABSTAINED FROM GIVING DETAILS OF THE INSPECTION. IN ONE OF THE FEW STATEMENTS MADE TO THE PRESS, MILITARY PROSECUTOR COL. RAUL TALLEDO ONLY SAID, "AS YOU CAN SEE, IT IS VERY DARK AT THIS TIME OF THE MORNING. THAT IS ALL I CAN SAY. YOU CAN DRAW YOUR OWN CONCLUSIONS."

(LOU) ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THERE WAS AN EXPLOSION ON THE CAMPUS ABOUT AN HOUR BEFORE THE INSPECTION BEGAN. NO DAMAGE OR INJURIES WERE REPORTED. THE SAME PRESS REPORTS SUGGESTED THE MILITARY INVESTIGATORS HAD TRIED TO INSPECT


