

3. (U) DEMOCRACY STATE OF PLAY: AMBASSADOR REQUESTED THE MEETING WITH PRESIDENT PANIAGUA TO GET THE PRESIDENT'S VIEWS FOR HIS UPCOMING WASHINGTON CONSULTATIONS. DCM ACCOMPANIED THE AMBASSADOR; PANIAGUA WAS ACCOMPANIED BY MFA PRESIDENTIAL AIDE LUIS UGATELLI. AMBASSADOR OPENED BY OUTLINING FOR

PRESIDENT PANIAGUA HOW WELL HE BELIEVED GOP AUTHORITIES ARE DOING IN PREPARING FOR THE APRIL 8 ELECTIONS, NOTING THAT DESPITE THE ENORMOUS LOGISTICAL CHALLENGES IN CARRYING OUT THESE ELECTIONS, AND EXPECTED COMPLAINTS FROM SOME POLITICAL PARTIES, HE WOULD CONVEY TO WASHINGTON AUTHORITIES HIS EXPECTATION THAT THESE ELECTIONS WOULD INDEED BE FREE AND FAIR. PANIAGUA AGREED AND EXPRESSED PLEASURE WITH THE AMBASSADOR'S REVIEW OF THE STATE OF PLAY, AND THEN ADDED A NUMBER OF ADDITIONAL ADVANCES IN DEMOCRACY HE THOUGHT IMPORTANT TO CONVEY. HE OUTLINED THE RETURN TO AUTONOMY AND APPROPRIATE INSTITUTIONAL BEHAVIOR OF THE PERUVIAN JUDICIAL AUTHORITIES SUCH AS THE NATIONAL MAGISTRATES COUNCIL (CNM), SUPREME COURT, AND PUBLIC MINISTRY. PANIAGUA TOOK LITTLE CREDIT FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS IN DEMOCRATIC GOVERNANCE, SAYING IT IS THE PERUVIAN PEOPLE WHO FEEL DEEPLY THIS DESIRE FOR A RETURN TO DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS.

 CREDITING THE USG, EU, OAS AND OTHERS. HE STRESSED THE
 IMPORTANCE OF THE TRUE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE "FRANJA
 ELECTORAL" OR ELECTORAL INFORMATION PROGRAM GIVING FREE
 AIRTIME ON MASS MEDIA TO ALL PARTIES PARTICIPATING IN THE
 ELECTIONS--SOMETHING HE SAID HAD NOT EVEN BEEN DONE FULLY IN
 PREVIOUS DEMOCRATIC GOVERNMENTS. AS ACHIEVEMENTS OF HIS
 GOVERNMENT PANIAGUA NOTED THE IMPORTANCE OF DIALOGUE AMONG
 GOVERNMENT AND CIVIL SOCIETY SECTORS IN AREAS SUCH AS THE
 LABOR/BUSINESS DIALOGUE AND POVERTY. HE ALSO HIGHLIGHTED
 HIS GOVERNMENT'S INAUGURATION OF THE GOVERNMENT BUDGET WEB
 SITE WHERE CITIZENS CAN MONITOR SPENDING, AND AGREEMENTS
 WITH AND INCREASED POWER TO MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENTS.
- 5. (U) FUTURE GOP AND USG POLICY: THE AMBASSADOR NOTED THAT A NEW PERUVIAN GOVERNMENT WILL HAVE TO CONTEND WITH ENORMOUSLY HIGH PUBLIC EXPECTATIONS, A TOUGH ECONOMIC SITUATION AND A LIKELY FRAGMENTED CONGRESS. HE NOTED, HOWEVER, AND PANIAGUA ENTHUSIASTICALLY AGREED, THAT THE STRONG DEMOCRATIC CREDENTIALS OF AN INCOMING ADMINISTRATION AND GOOD MANAGEMENT OF POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC ISSUES BY THE TRANSITION GOVERNMENT WOULD GREATLY AID A NEW GOP.
- 6. (SBU) TURNING TO WHAT HE WOULD URGE THE US GOVERNMENT TO FOCUS ON WITH A NEW PERUVIAN GOVERNMENT, THE AMBASSADOR SAID HE SOUGHT SUSTAINED ENGAGEMENT IN SUPPORT OF PERU, IN AREAS






