

Congressman Dan Glickman recently wrote to me to raise concerns regarding human rights abuses in Peru and the role that the head of the National Intelligence Service Vladimiro Montesinos and Army Intelligence may have played in these abuses. In response, I indicated that the staff of the National Security Council would conduct an interagency review on this subject.

I have directed Dr. Morton H. Halperin, Senior Director for Democracy, to conduct this study. I am writing to request that agencies fully cooperate in this study by (1) designating staff on request to participate in the interagency review, (2) making knowledgeable staff available for interviews, (3) providing copies of all relevant documents in the possession of your agency, and (4) providing appropriate administrative support, including travel, as may be needed for the study.
