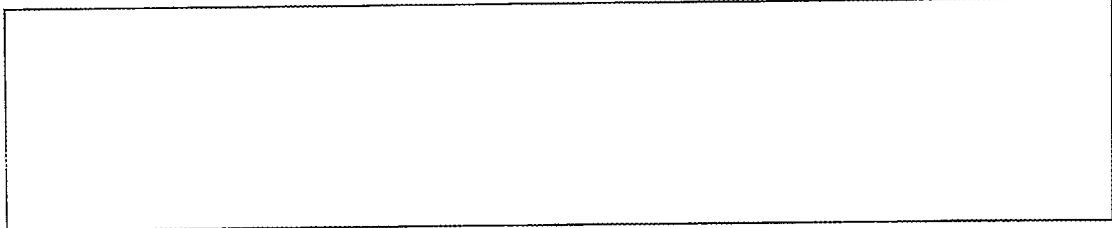

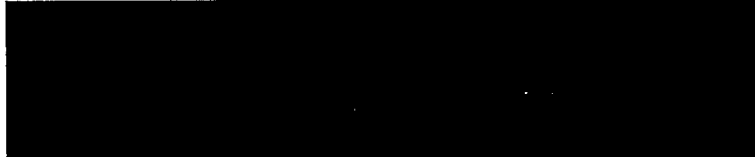

(U) WHILE WITHIN RANGE OF SENDERO LUMINOSO (SL) AND TUPAC AMARU REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENT (MRTA) UNITS OPERATING IN THE SAN MARTIN DEPARTMENT, THE UCAYALI AND HUANACO DEPARTMENTS HAVE EXPERIENCED LITTLE TERRORIST ACTIVITY WITHIN THE LAST YEAR. DESPITE PREVIOUSLY HIGH LEVELS IN THE PAST, THESE AREAS HAVE NOT EXPERIENCED THE HIGH CONCENTRATION OF SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITY THAT OTHER DEPARTMENTS HAVE.

SIX SL INSURGENTS WERE IN A FIREFIGHT WITH SOLDIERS.

JANUARY 13, LEONCIO PRADO-HUANUCO:

APPROXIMATELY 30 TERRORISTS, WEARING MILITARY UNIFORMS ASSASSINATED SEVEN RURAL PATROLMEN IN THE COMMUNITY OF JULIO C. TELLO LOCATED AT 30 KILOMETERS TO THE NORTH EAST OF TINGO MARIA NEAR THE LEFT BANK OF THE HUALLAGA RIVER.

FEBRUARY 23, CRESPO Y CASTILLO-LEONCIO-HUANUCO:
SL INSURGENTS ASSASSINATED TWELVE CIVILIANS.

FEBRUARY 27, CRESPO Y CASTILLO-LEONCIO PRADO-HUANUCO:
THE POLITICAL AND MILITARY COMMAND OF THE HUALLAGA FRONT RELEASED AN OFFICIAL COMMUNICATION REGARDING A CONFRONTATION BETWEEN AN ARMY PATROL AND SL TERRORISTS WHICH TOOK PLACE IN AN AREA LOCATED BETWEEN PAMPA HERMOZA AND SAN PABLO. ONE SOLDIER WAS SHOT AND KILLED, AND ANOTHER FOUR ARMY MEMBERS, INCLUDING A LIEUTENANT, WERE WOUNDED. THREE TERRORISTS WERE ALSO KILLED. ONE FAL RIFLE AND ONE AKM RIFLE WERE CONFISCATED.

FIFTEEN ALLEGED SL INSURGENTS WERE ARRESTED BY THE NATIONAL
POLICE. PNP SEIZED ONE MGP MACHINE GUN, ONE STAR 9 MM
PISTOL, ONE SW 38 REVOLVER, THREE HAND GRENADES, A LARGE
AMOUNT OF AMMUNITION, AND THREE RADIOS WERE SEIZED.

PERPETRATORS REMOVED HIS RIFLE (G3-A3-4067) AND HIS
