Coletta Youngers of WOLA just called to tell me Gen. Rodolfo Robles was abducted this morning at 10:15, while going from his house to the corner to buy a newspaper. Two cars with polarized windows came by, and he was forced into one, according to witnesses on the spot. The licenses of the cars were: JQ7256, and HQ 8299. One of the cars was a blue Toyota. The Peruvian witnesses told WOLA they believe the abduction may have been carried out by the intelligence service, because of the way it was done. Coletta said she had already spoken with Henry Bisharat, who will talk to the Ambassador. You already knew about this, right? Martha
