2. (C) SUMMARY. THE MFA HAS DIRECTLY EMPHASIZED TO US THE SERIOUSNESS WITH WHICH THE GOVERNMENT IS TAKING THE INVESTIGATION OF VLADINIRO MONTESINOS' SWISS BANK ACCOUNTS AND OTHER ALLEGATIONS OF MONEY LAUNDERING. ALSO NOTING THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE MATTER, PRESIDENT FUJIMORI HELD A PRESS CONFERENCE TODAY (NOVEMBER 3) IN WHICH HE SAID MONTESINOS HAD TO RESPOND TO THESE CHARGES. WE HAVE STRESSED TO THEM OUR DESIRE TO BE HELPFUL IN THIS INVESTIGATION, IF ASSISTANCE IS REQUESTED AND APPROPRIATE. 
