#### MEETING WITH ARA PDAS ROMERO

IN HIS MEETING WITH PDAS ROMERO DESCRIBED WHAT HE CALLED A CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE OPPOSITION AS STARTING IN A SENSE WITH THE OCTOBER 1996 BOMBING OF A PUNO TELEVISION STATION WHICH HAD BROADCAST OPPOSITION TELEVISION PROGRAMS. 
