PROTESTS CONTINUE ON SMALLER SCALE, SOME VIOLENCE

IN HIS MEETING WITH THE PRESIDENT OF CONGRESS, SANTISTEVAN SAID POLICE HAD, FOR THE MOST PART, EXERCISED RESTRAINT. HE SAID THEY HAD USED EXCESSIVE FORCE IN A FEW INSTANCES AND THERE HAD BEEN INJURIES, BUT POLICE HAD NOT USED ANY FIREARMS TO QUELL DISTURBANCES. THE OMBUDSMAN'S OFFICE RELEASED A STATEMENT MAY 29 REPORTING THAT POLICE HAD ARRESTED 445 PROTESTERS ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND HAD RELEASED ABOUT HALF, LEAVING OVER 200 STILL IN CUSTODY. A TOTAL OF 130 INJURIES HAD BEEN REPORTED NATIONWIDE, INCLUDING ONE WOMAN FROM LIMA IN SERIOUS CONDITION.

MAY 29-30 PRESS REPORTS INDICATED THAT PROTESTS CONTINUED ON A SMALLER SCALE ACROSS THE COUNTRY. TV NEWS FOOTAGE FROM HUANCAYO SHOWED POLICE USING TEARGAS TO DISPERSE AROUND 300 DEMONSTRATORS, THROWING ROCKS AT A MUNICIPAL BUILDING AND BREAKING WINDOWS. IN AREQUIPA, POLICE HAVE SEALED OFF THE TOWN CENTER AND HAVE DEPLOYED A HEAVY PRESENCE. SOURCES IN AREQUIPA REPORTED MINOR

SKIRMISHES. IN JUNIN, POLICE THWARTED PROTESTORS' ATTEMPT TO ATTACK GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS. IN LIMA, 500 MARCHED PEACEFULLY IN THE CENTRAL PLAZA TO DEMAND THE RELEASE OF PROTESTERS ARRESTED MAY 28. PEACEFUL RALLIES WERE ALSO REPORTED IN CHIMBOTE, TRUJILLO, AND CHICLAYO.

COMMENT: TOLEDO AND PRESIDENT FUJIMORI ARE BOTH DIGGING IN.
