- 2. SUHMARY:

THE DEPARTMENT OF PUND, BORDERING BOLIVIA AND ENCOMPASSING LAKE FITICACA, HAC BEEN RELATIVELY QUIET FOR THE LAST YEAR, BUT APPEARS HOW ON THE VERGE OF RENEWED LAND TENURE DISPUTES AND TERRORIST VIOLENCE THE GOVERNMENT'S "AGRARIAN RESTRUCTURING, " WHICH ENDED IN JUNE, 1987, WAS FAILED TO DEFUSE THE DEMANDS OF FEASANT CONHUNITIES FOR HORE LAND. THE CONHUNITIES ARE WELL ORGANIZED INTO A CAMPESINO CONFEDER-ALIGN (FOCP) THAT IS AFFILIATED WITH THE RADICAL LEFTIST UNITED MARIATEQUIST PARTY (PUM). THE FOCP CARRIED OUT LARGE-SCALE LAND INVASIONS LAST MAY AND JUNE; IT IS REPORTECLY PLANNING FOR JUNE A NEW SERIES OF HASSIVE INVASIONS OF LANDS BELONGING TO BUSINESS-GRIENTED COOPERATIVES. THE PUNO CHURCH AND HUMAN RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS SUPPORT THE PEASANT COMMUNITIES. SENDERO LUHINOSO, DEALT A SIGNIFICANT SETRACK IN 1986-1987, RESURFACED IN FEBRUARY. ON HAY S IT CARRIED OUT A BARBARIC HURDER OF SIX POLICEMEN AND A JUDGE IN GRUCERO, A SITE OF INTERSE LAND CONFLICT ABOUT 2 HOURS WORTH OF THE CITY OF PUNO. THAT AND OTHER INCIDENTS HAD EVERYONE WE TALKED TO DURING A HAY 17-18 VISIT ON EDGE.

HIMAN RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS HAVE CREDIBLE EVIDENCE OF CONTINUING POLICE (AND SOME ARMY)

ABUSES, MANY INVOLVING POLICE EFFORTS TO DISCOUGE SOURTIERS. BUT THE LEVEL OF SERIOUS ABUSE IS NOT GREAT, BELLTH TO AVACUATO, FOF EXAMPLET, APRA PARAMILITARY ACTIVITY HAS DROPPED OFF, AND THERE IS SOME COMMUNICATION SETUREN CHURCH/MUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS AND THE POLICE. THE POLICE COMMANDER, A QUESHUA SPEAKER, IS IMPRESSIVE; HE HAS A FAMILIAR TALF OF IMADEQUATE

A BRIGHT SPOT IS THE HEAD OF THE AGRICULTURE MINISTRY'S REGIONAL OFFICE -- P WIDELY RESPECTED AND HARD-WORKING BUREAUCRAT WITH TOO FEW FINGERS TO PLUG THE DIKE. END SUMMARY,

## REFORMS

THE YELASCO REFORM: DESPITE TWO REFORMS IN THE LAST SEVENTREM YEARS; COMPLICT OVER LAND CONTINUES TO DRIVE POLITICS IN PUNO THE VELASCO GOVERNMENT EXPROPRIATED ALL THE LARGE HACIENDAS IN THE EARLY 1570'S; TRANSFERRING THILE TO THE COMPESING FAMILIES WAS VORKED ON THE PACIENDAS AT THAT TIME. TODAY THERE ARE NO SINGLE-OWNER LARGE HOLDINGS OF LAND. TO AVOID "MINIFUNDIZATION" AND TO MAINTAIN ECONOMIES OF SCALE, HOWEVER, THE VELASCO REFORM DID NOT BREAK UP THE HACIENDAS. INSTEAD; IT CONSOL'DATED THEN INTO 46 BUSINESS-OPIENTED COOPERATIVES ENFRESAS ASOCIATIVAS). THERE ARE THREE FORMS OF THESE COOPERATIVES, KNOWN LOCALLY BY THEIR ACPONYMS: SAIS (SOCIEDAD AGRICOLA DE INTERES SOCIAL); ERFS CEMPRESA RURAL DE PROPIEDAD SOCIAL); AND CAP (COOPERATIVA AGRARIA DE PRODUCTORES). VELASCO THUS IGNORED THE CLAIMS OF THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES THAT THEIR ANGESTRAL LANDS BE RETURNED TO THEM.

5. THE VELASCO CONCEPT WAS THAT THE COOPERATIVES WOULD BE HANAGED TO THE BENEFIT OF PUND AS A WHOLE: SURPLUS PRODUCTION WOULD GO TO LOCAL MARKETS; PROFITS WOULD BE INVESTED LOCALLY; AND THERE WOULD BE A CLOSE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE COOPERATIVES AND THE FEASANT COMMUNITIES (CONUNIDADES CAMPESINOS). THE PEASANT CONHUNITIES EXISTED OUTSIDE THE HACIENDA SYSTEM AND DID NOT BENEFIT DIRECTLY FROM THE VELASCO REFORM. INSTEAD, NOWEVER, AND ACCORDING TO APRA AND MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AS WELL AS FOOP AND CHURCH SOURCES. THE COOPERATIVES HAVE COME, OVER TIME, UNDER THE CONTROL OF A NEW CLASS OF TECHNICIANS -- AGRONOMISTS. ACCOUNTANTS, VETERINARIANS AND LAWYERS -- WHO OPERATE THE COOPERATIVES TO THEIR OWN BENEFIT. THEY DO THIS BY MAKING ALLIANCE WITH FOUR OR FIVE MEY CAMP-ESING FAMILIES OF THE 198 OR SO THAT MAKE UP -EACH COOPERATIVE. . THESE TECHNICAL PROFESSIONALS ARE OFTEN THE FIRST GENERATION OF CAMPESIROS

TO RECEIVE HORE THAN A SECONDARY SCHOOL
EDUCATION AND HANY ARE FORHER LEFTIST POLITICAL
ACTIVISTS. ACCORDING TO THE HIMISTRY OF
AGRICULTURE'S MERCADO. THE VELASCO PEFORN WAS
DRAWN UP VITHOUT THE BENEFIT OF ACCURATE
CENSUS DATA AND THE POPULATION OF THE CAMPESING
COMMUNITIES WAS SERIOUSLY UNDERESTIMATED. SINCE
THE EARLY 1978'S THESE COMMUNITIES MAVE GROWN
RAPIDLY AND HAVE BECOME MARKEDLY POLITICIZED.

7. LEFT OUT AND INCREASINGLY DISGRUNTLED ARE. THE 195 OR SO ILLITERATE CAMPESING FAMILIES WHO ACTUALLY HOLD TITLE TO THE COOPERATIVE LAND AND SOME 786 CAMPESING COMMUNITIES. THE LATTER CONSIST OF ABOUT 150 FAMILIES EACH. AT FIVE PER FAMILY, THERE IS THUS A TOTAL POPULATION OF ABOUT 325, 888 PEOPLE -- A LITTLE HORE THAN HALF THE TOTAL POPULATION OF PURO DEPARTMENT --IN THE LAND-POOR CAMPESING COMMUNITIES. BEFORE THE GARCIA PEFORN, THE CAMPESING CONHUNITIES TENDED TO HAVE ABOUT ONE HEGTARE OF LAND PER FAMILY -- FOR A TOTAL OF ROUGHLY 105,080 RECTARES. THE SITUATION OF THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES CONTRASTS SHARPLY WITH THAT OF THE BENEFICIARIES OF THE COOPERATIVE SYSTEM. THERE ARE 46 COOPERATIVES AND SOME 200 CAMPESINO FAMILIES PER COOPERATIVE FOR A TOTAL OF ABOUT 5, 200 LAND-DWHING FAMILIES (AND A TOTAL POPULATION ON THE COOPERATIVES OF ABOUT 46, 889). PRIOR TO THE GARCIA REFORM, THE COOFERATIVES HELD ABOUT 1,700,000 HECTARES OF LAND, OR ABOUT 185 HECTARES PER FAMILY. THIS COMPARISON IS PORTRAJED IN THE TABLE BELOW.

FIGURES FOR THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES PROSABLY EXCLUDE SOME DRY PASTURE AND OTHER LANDS OF HARGINAL UTILITY.

8. THE GARGIA "AGRARIAN RESTRUCTURING: " THIS MANIFEST INEQUALITY OF LAND TENURE WAS BEING EXPLOITED POLITICALLY BY BOTH THE RADICAL LEFT CHOTABLY THE UNITED HARIATEGUIST PARTY, OR PUMP AND BY SENDERO LUMINOSO (SLI: SENDERO BEGAN ORGANIZING IN PUNG AROUND 1922 BUT DID NOT REGIA MAJOR VIOLENT ACTIVITY UNTIL 1985. IN DECEMBER, 1985, PRESIDENT GARCIA IN A THREE-DAY MEETING WITH THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES IN PURO ("RIMANACUY" -- QUECHUA FOR DIPLOSUE) PROMISED TO CARRY DUL AN "AGRARIAN RESTRUCTURING" TO REDISTRIBUTE 1, 180, 800 HECTARES OF LAND HELD BY THE COOPERATIVES. THAT PROMISE PUT AN END TO LARGE-SCALE LAND INVASIONS FOR THE BETTER PART OF A YEAR, AS THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES WAITED TO SEE WHAT WOULD HAPPEN. IT ALSO GAVE A SIGNIFICANT BOOST IN THE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

OF NOVEMBER, 1936 (A NUMBER OF TITLES WERE

POSITIONS. MHER THE PROGRAM ENDED IN JUNE, 1987,

S. THAT CLAIM IS FLATLY DISPUTED BY THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES AND THEIR ALLIES -- THE CHURCH AND HUHAN RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS. ACCORDING TO THESE, THE GOP REDISTRIBUTED NO HORE THAN A HALF MILLION HECTARES. . THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES FURTHER COMPLAIN THAT THE LAND THAT HAS BEEN REDISTRIBUTED IS DISPERSED IN SMALL PLOTS AND TENDS TO BE ROCKY AND THE LEAST FERTILE. THE DIRECTOR OF THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE'S REGIONAL OFFICE IN PUNO, WALTER HERCADO, SAYS "BOTH SIDES ARE RIGHT." THE GOVERNMENT DID IN FACT CHANGE TITLE TO HORE THAN & HILLION HECTARES. HERCADO SAYS, BUT A SIGNIFICANT PORTION, NEARLY 598, 698 HECTARES, DIO NOT 60 TO THE CAMPESING COMMUNICIES. IT WAS INSTEAD SIPHONED OFF TO THREE TYPES OF REGIPIENTS: STATE ENTITIES FOR AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH STATIONS AND THE LIKE+; A SPECIAL CATEGORY OF EMBLESS PEAGANTS, LEGALLY-DISTINCT FROM THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES CALLED AGRICULTURAL GROUPS WITHOUT LAND IKNOWN BY THE SPANISH ACRONYN GASSI; AND TO CAMPESING FAMILIES THAT ARE COOPERATIVE MEMBERS II.E. A REDISTRIBUTION WITHIN THE COOPERATIVE SYSTEM). HERCADO HOTES THAT THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES ARE UNVILLING TO COUNT THE REDISTRIBUTION OF LAND TO THESE RECIPIENTS AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT S PLEDGE.

18. LAND INVASIONS AND DISLODGINGS: THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES TO SUSPEND LAND INVASIONS AND OTHER FORMS OF PRESSURE ENDED IN MAY, 1987, OR THE EVE OF THE REFORM'S TERMINATION. ON MAY 19, THE FDCP INVADED HEARLY 150,000 HECTARES OF LAND; A MONTH LATER, OH JUNE 24, HORE INVASIONS UPPED THE TOTAL OF ILLEGALLY-OCCUPIED LANDS TO 35#. GRB. WITH THE HELP OF THE POLICE AND IN SOME INSTANCES THE ARMY, THE COOPERATIVES MAVE OVER THE COURSE OF THE LAST YEAR PUSHED THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES OFF SOME 288, 488 MEGTARES OF THE 350,800 OCCUPIED. THE PROCESS WAS BEEN OFTEN VIOLENT. ON MAY 22, AN FOCP LEADER, PEDRO LAURA OCHOCHOQUE, WAS SHOT BY AM ARMY (AND DIED HOURS LATER) AS HE AND OTHER LEADERS WITHDREW FROM A CONFRONTATION WITH THE ARMY AND THE LEADER OF THE ASSOCIATION OF COOPERATIVES, HAROLD CHAVEZ. MORE THAN THE POLICE OR ANY GOVERNMENT FIGURE, CHAVEZ IS THE SINGLE PERSON WHO SYMBOLIZES WHAT THE FDCP, CHURCK AND HUMAN RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS CALL THE "STRUCTURE OF INJUSTICE.") ACCORDING TO CHURCH SOURCES, HORE THAN 388 PEASANTS HAVE BEEN DETAINED FOR PROLONGED PERIODS AND SEVERAL DOZEN SHOT AND WOUNDED IN THE PROCESS OF DISCODGING THE LAND INVADERS.

11. ACCORDING TO THE CHURCH, THE PUND HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION AND THE FDCP, SINCE MAY-JUNE, 1987 THE COOPERATIVES HAVE PROVIDED THE POLICE
- "BASES" ON THE COOPERATIVES THEMSELVES AND ARE GIVING THE POLICE FOOD AND CLOTHING. CIVIL GUARD COMMANDER SCROA AND MERCADO DO INCT DENY THAT THIS IS MAPPENING IN SOME INSTANCES, BUT SAY ITS EXTENT IS EXAGGERATED. IN PROTESTING POLICE AND COOPERATIVE VIOLENCE AGAINST THE LAWADING CAMPESINOS, CHURCH AND HUMAN RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS "OINT OUT THAT THE LAMD INVASIONS HAVE BEEN CARRIED OUT "PEACEFULLY," 1.E. WITHOUT WEAPONS. THEY ADMIT, HOWEVER, THAT THE INVASIONS EMPLOY FORCE, THAT THERE IS NO LEGAL

THESE CHURCH AND HUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS, HOXEVER,

JUSTIFIES THE INVASIONS.

12. MORE INVASIONS NOW LOOM: FDCP SECRETARY GENERAL GREGORIO TRICONA GONEZ GAVE THE CLEAR IMPRESSION THAT MORE INVASIONS ARE BEING PLANNED FOR THE NEAR FUTURE. CHERCADO REINFORCED THIS, SAYING THAT FDCP INVASIONS FOR JUNE ARE "STRONGLY RUMORED,") ALTHOUGH HE DID NOT TALK ABOUT INVASIONS, PER SE, TRICONA DID SAY THAT THE FDCP GOAL IS TO SEE ALL THE COOPERATIVES DISHAHTLED AND THEIR LANDS GIVEN TO THE PEASANT COMMUNITIES. HIS TOHE AND HANNER CONVEYED IMPATIENCE. TRICONA WAS BITTERLY CRITICAL OF THE GARCIA AGRARIAN REFORM BUT GAVE MERCADO GRUDGING CREDIT AS WELL-INTENTIONED. LAST OCTOBER, FOLLOWING AN INVASION OF THE BUENAVISTA COOPERATIVE CHEAR JULIACA) AND A LARGE FOCP RALLY IN PUND (ATTENDED BY PUH SENATOR JAVIER DIEZ CANSECO), TRICONA, DIEZ CANSECO AND UNITED LEFT DEPUTY ALBERTO QUINTANILLA SIGNED A JOINT STATEMENT WITH MERCADO AND THE PREFECT OF PUNO AGREEING TO SET UP A WORKING GROUP TO SEEK NON-VIOLENT SOLUTIONS. THE WORKING GROUP IS IN THE PROCESS OF RESOLVING THE BUENAVISTA INVASION ON TERMS FAVORABLE TO THE INVADERS (THE OWNERS . ARE APPARENTLY WILLING TO GEDE LARGE SECTIONS OF THEIR LAND), BUT IS NOT OTHERLISE MAYING ANY SUCCESS.

ALTHOUGH THERE WAS A DEGREE OF VIOLENCE ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONFLICT OVER LAND IN-PUNO IN 1987, TERRORIST VIOLENCE DROPFED OFF TO NOTHING AFTER THE APRIL 27, 1987 SHOOT-OUT AT CUTUTUDE THAT KILLED THE SEVEN TOP SENDERO LEADERS IN PUNO THAT RESPITE CAME TO A HALT FEBPUARY 24, 1988, WHEN A SENDERO COLUMN STOPPED A CORPUND VEHICLE NEGR SANTA ROSA AND HILLED OSCAR CAVIESES TORRE, ONE OF ITS PASSENGERS. ' IALSO, A BOLIVIAN NATIONAL WAS MOUNDED ) CAVIESES WAS A CORPUNO EMPLOYEE BUT IT IS NOT CLEAR WHAT HIS JOB WAS; HE MAY HAVE BEEN A SECURITY OFFICIAL. SCUTTLEBUTT AMONG CHURCH AND NUMAR RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS HAD HIM AS PREVIOUSLY ACTIVE IN APRA FARA-MILITARY GROUPS.

14. CRUCERO INCIDENT: ON MAY 5, SENDERO CARRIED OUT A BRUTAL ATTACK AGAINST A POLICE STATION IN CRUCERO, A MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY EIGHT HOURS HORTH OF PUND. THERE, A SERDERO GROUP OF ABOUT 38 INDIVIDUALS ATTACKED WITH DYNAMITE AND GUIS A POLICE STATION, -KILLING SOME AND WOUNDING OTHERS OF THE SIX POLICE INSIDE. THE STATION WAS THEN SET AFIRE; SEVERAL OF THE WOUNDED RAN OUT WITH CLOTPING AFLANE AND LATER DIED OF THEIR GUNSHOT WOUNDS, AND BURNS. THE SL COLUMN ALSO SEARCHED OUT A LOCAL JUDGE, MURDERING HIM IN HIS BED. THE SAME MIGHT, THE COLUMN ATTACKED A HEARBY COOPERATIVE, DESTROYING EQUIPMENT BUT NOT KILLING ANYONE. OTHER INCIDENTS FOCLOWED, INCLUDING A CAR BONB IN PUNO HAY 13 THAT FALLED TO EXPLODE AND THE HURDER OF TWO POLICEMEN SEVERAL DAYS AFTER OUR VISIT.

15. THE CRUCERO INCIDENT IN PARTICULAR WAS ON THE MINDS OF EVERYONE WE TALKED TO IN OUR TWO-DAY WIST. NOT ONLY DID IT SIGNAL THE RETURN OF SENDERO WITH RENEWED BRUTALITY, BUT IT ALSO REVEALED THE INTENT OF SL TO INVOLVE LYSELF AGAIN IN LAND DISPUTES. AT THE TIPE

OF THE CRUCERO INCIDENT, THE FDCP MAS AGITATING
AGAINST A COOPERATIVE THERE, SAIS AGRICONA,
WHOSE DIRECTOR IS HAROLD CHAVEZ, THE LEADER
OF THE COOPERATIVES ASSOCIATION. THE POLICE
RESPONSE TO THE SL ATTACK WAS TO ARREST
FIVE FDCP\_LEADERS. THEIR DETENTION HAS SINCE

16. POLICE COMMANDER SERPA WAS RELUCTART TO . BE DRAWN INTO DISCUSSING THE PARTICULARS OF THE CRUCERO ENCIDENT, WHICH HE NOTED IS STILL UMDER INVESTIGATION. HE DID CONNENT HORE GENERALLY THAT SE WAS BEEN QUIETLY PEBUILDING ITS INFRASTPUCTURE DURING THE LAST YEAR ISERPA HAS BEEN IN HIS FOSITION FOR THREE MONTHS). TPICONA SAID THAT THE FOCE WAS AWARE OF THE SL COLUMN'S EXISTENCE FRIOR TO THE 'INCIDENT -- IT HAD BEEN IN AZANGARO PROVINCE, HE SAID. TRICONA CLAIMED THAT THE FDCP AND SE ARE MUTUALLY ANTAGONISTIC AND WAS BITTER THAT THE POLICE HAD REACTED TO THE CRUCERO INCIDENT AS HE CLAIMS SL INTENDED BY CRACKING DOWN ON THE FOCE. THEY HAD WELL-DOCUMENTED ACCOUNTS OF FOUR DEATHS THEY WERE ATTEMPTING TO PURSUE LEGALLY -- TWO INVOLVENG THE POLICE ARMY ON DUTY, TWO INVOLVENG DRUNK POLICEMEN

OFF DOTY: THEY ALSO CLAIMED THAT THERE WERE SOME THREE HUNDRED INSTANCES OF CAMPESTHOS DETAINED WITHOUT CHARGES AND A HALF DOZEN TO A DOZEN INSTANCES OF CAMPESTHOS BEING WOUNDED DURING POLICE ACTIONS TO DISCODISE LAND INVADERS. THEY CITED A FAMILIAR LITAMY: POLICE ARROGANCE, LACK OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING, CORRUPTION AND INVOLVEMENT IN COMPRABAND. SOME OF THESE POINTS WERE VOLUNTARILY CONFIRMED BY POLICE COMMANDER SEPPA, WHO COMPLATHED THAT THE SUCIO-ECONOMIC AND EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND OF HIS POLICE PERSONNEL HADE THEM VIRTURLLY IMPOSSIBLE TO TRAIN IN RESPECT FOR HUMAN RIGHTS.

18. THE OVERALL LEVEL OF SERIOUS ABUSE. HOWEVER, DID NOT APPEAR TO BE GREAT RELATIVE TO OTHER AREAS OF PERU, AND APRA PARAMILITARY ACTIVITY A PROBLEM IN 1986 -- HAD NOT RETURNED. THERE WAS ALSO A HINOR BRIGHT SPOT. LAST NOVEMBER THE HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION HAD ORGANIZED A SEMINAR FOR 128 POLICE OFFICIALS. COMMISSION PRESIDENT GIRALDA SALO THAT SHE AND HER COLLEAGUES NAO BEEN IMPRESSED BY THO THINGS: THE DEPTH OF POLICE IGHORANCE OF THE LAY AND PRESSURES, FEARS AND "FERSONAL ANGUISM" TO WHICH THE POLICE ARE SUBJECT. GIRALDA AND ZAMBRANO HAD FOLLOWED UP BY MAINTAIHING COMMUNICATIONS WITH SERPA, BUT WERE CAREFUL NOT TO EXAGGERATE PROSPECTS FOR IMPROVING THE NUMAN RIGHTS SITUATION IN THE SHORT TERM.

19. STRONG SUPPORT FOR REGIONALIZATION. CEVERAL PEOPLE SAID THERE IS STRONG SUPPORT IN PUNO FOR THE GARCIA GOVERNMENT'S REGIONALIZATION PROJECT. THIS SUPPORT APPARENTLY EXTENDS ACROSS THE POLITICAL SPECTRUM. THERE IS NOT YET AGREEMENT ON WHICH DEPARTMENTS WILL JOIN WITH PUNO. HOST LIKELY, THE NEW REGION WILL COMBINE PUNO. HOST AREQUIPA WILL COMBINE PUNO AREQUIPA WILL CETTAINLY NOT BE INCLUDED PUNO HAS LONG BEEN ECONOMICALLY DEFENDENT ON AND RESENTFUL TOWARD AREQUIPA. OHE MEARS THE COMMENT

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THAT ABSENTEE HACIENDA OWNERS USED TO LIVE IH
AREQUIPA AND THAT PROFITS FROM CUOPERATIVE
OPERATIONS ARE INVESTED THERE INSTEAD OF LOCALLY.
RIGHTLY OR WRONGLY, PUMO RESIDENTS TEND TO SEE
THE REGIONALIZATION SCREER AS A WAY TO BREAK
AWAY FROM THE ECONOMIC EMBRACE OF AREQUIPA AND
AS AN EXIT FROM ITS POVERTY AND UNDERDEVELOPMENT.
THE EXPECTATION LS FOR FEDERAL LEGISLATION TO

28. DIFFERENCE IN THE AYMARA AND QUECHUA SPEAKING
- COMMUNITIES:

CORNELL-TRAINED ANTHROPOLOGIST FELIX PALACIOS, A PUNG NATIVE, HAD INTERESTING OBSERVATIONS ON THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE AYMARA AND QUECHNA COMMUNITIES. WOTE: PALACIOS WORKS PRINCIPALLY WITH THE AYMARAS AND CLEARLY PREFERS THEM. THE QUECKUAS TEND TO BE HUCH MORE SUSPICIOUS OF AND CLOSED TO OUTSIDERS THAN THE AYMARAS, FOR WHON HOSPITALITY TO STRANGERS IS A CULTURAL IMPERATIVE. THE AYMARAS MAVE STRONG COMMUNAL ORGANIZATION, PALACIOS SAYS, BUT ARE ESSENTIALLY INDIVIOUALISTIC IN THEIR OUTLOOK. THEY HAVE SUBSTANTIAL PRIDE IN THEIR OWN CULTURE AND ARE OPEN TO OUTSIDE INFLUENCES. "BORN HERCHANIS," THE AYMARAS ARE DEEPLY INVOLVED IN COUTFABARD WITH BOLIVIA. SIMILARLY, THEY ARE READY TO COLLABORATE WITH THE MORE THAN 35 PUBLIC AND PRIVATE FOREIGN AID AGENCIES THAT HAVE OR MAVE HAD PROJECTS IN PUNO IN RECENT YEARS. THEY ARE DEMANDING IN REGOTIATING THE TERMS OF PROJECT AGREEMENTS AND QUICKLY ADJUST TO THE FERMINATION OF ONE PROJECT AND INITIATION OF ANOTHER. THEY

THE ARHY COMMANDER IS UNKNOWN IN THE COMMUNITY. POLICE COMMANDER SERPA IS, ON THE OTHER HAND, IMPRESSIVE. HE IS A QUECHUA SPEAKER WHO HAS OPENEDUP SOME LINES OF CONMUNICATION TO THE CAMPESINGCOM-HUNITIES AND IS KEEPING UP A DIALOGUE WITHTHE HUHAN RIGHTS GROUPS. HE HAS ON HIS OWN NITIATIVE SET UP A TRAINING CENTER FOR POLICE OUSIDE THE CITY AND IS TAYING TO FREE UP MORE OF IS 1698-HAN POLICE FORCE FOR PATROLLING THE COUTRYSIDE. HE PRESENTLY HAS FOUR 38-HAN HOBILE PTROLS. HE HAS LITTLE IN THE WAY OF COMMUNICATING OR GROUND TRANSPORT. AGRICULTURAL OFFICE DIRETOR HERCADO WAS ALSO IMPRESSIVE. HE WON PRAISE ROM CHURCH AND HUMAN RIGHTS LEADERS AS A GODD MR IN AR IMPOSSIBLE JOB. HE HAD ALSO JUST COME TROUGH A COSTLY STRIKE,

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WHICH HE HAD FINALLY SETLED BY GOING STRAIGHT
TO PRESIDENT GARCIA.

22. THE PUNO HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION LEADERSHIP (GIRALDA) IS EMERGETIC AND CAPABLE, AS IS THE CHURCH'S (ZAMBRANO -- WE DID NOT MEET THE BISHOP, WHO IS ALSO RESPECTED). BOTH THE CONHISSION AN THE CHURCH HAVE ACTIVE, WELL-ATTENDED PROGREMS OF SUPPORT TO THE CAMPESING COMMUNITIES. THE CHURCH OPERATES A RADIO STATION, RADIO ONDA AZU, THAT BROADCASTS IN SPANISH, QUECHUA AND AVMAR. ITS DIRECTOR, RAUL RODRIGUEZ, STRUCK US AS A INFORMAL COMMUNITY LEADER. THE FDCP'S TRICONA - YOUNG AND ROUGH IN APPEARANCE --CAHE ACROSS S BITTER, RADICAL AND UNCOMPRO-MISING. HIS ARLYSIS OF THE LAND TENURE SIT-UATION WAS THOROGHLY MARXIST IN CONTENT AND LANGUAGE. HE GAVE S AN HOUR AND A HALF OF HIS TIME, HOWEVER, AND SEMED ANXIOUS TO CONVEY FDCP OPPOSITION TO SENDEO. ANTHROPOLOGIST FELIX PALACIOS HAY BE ANOTHE INFORMAL COMMUNITY LEADER. HE IMPRESSED US ASMODERATE AND THOUGHTFUL.
