3. SUMMARY

NO USG PERSONNEL OR FACILITY WAS THE TARGET OF TERRORIST VIOLENCE FOR THE REPORTING PERIOD. PERUVIAN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITIES, AND ESPECIALLY THE POLICE, CONTINUED AS THE TARGETS OF CHOICE. THE MOST NOTABLE EVENT WAS THE ASSASSINATION OF LAWYER CARMEN ROSA CUSQUEN CABRERE. MS. CUSQUEN WAS A MEMBER OF MRTA AND WAS ACCUSED BY THAT GROUP OF BEING A TRAITOR. THIS WAS THE FIRST PUBLIC POLITICAL ASSASSINATION BY MRTA. WATSON
