3. OVERVIEW:

PERU'S RAPIDLY DETERIORATING ECONOMY DOMINATED POLITICAL EVENTS IN AUGUST AND EARLY SEPTEMBER. RUMORS THAT ECONOMY MINISTER ROBLES WAS ON HIS WAY OUT BEGAN IN MID-AUGUST. PRESIDENT GARCIA REPORTEDLY OFFERED THE POSITION TO OPPOSITION SENATOR AND FORMER FINANCE MINISTER JAVIER SILVA RUETE AND PUBLICLY CALLED ON HIM TO PROPOSE CORRECTIVE MEASURES. HAVING BEEN BURNED LAST MARCH BY SUPPORTING STRONGER MEASURES THAN THOSE THE PRESIDENT ULTIMATELY APPROVED, SILVA ON THIS OCCASION REFUSED TO BE SMOKED OUT. HE BLASTED GARCIA FOR ECONOMIC MISMANAGEMENT AND SAID THE MESS WAS HIS PERSONALLY TO CLEAN UP. OTHER RESPECTED OPPOSITION FIGURES ALSO FOCUSED THE BLAME DIRECTLY ON GARCIA IN SOMETIMES BRUTAL

LANGUAGE. WHEN THE CABINET SHUFFLE CAME ON SEPTEMBER 2, ROBLES AND TWO OTHERS LEFT, ENERGY AND MINES MINISTER SALINAS REPLACING ROBLES. SALINAS PRESENTED THE GOP'S ANTI-INFLATION PLAN SEPTEMBER 6; PUBLIC AND POLITICAL REACTION HAS SO FAR BEEN RELATIVELY SUBDUED, BUT IS BEGINNING TO BUILD.

AS THE CABINET WAS DEBATING THE PLAN, PRESIDENT GARCIA PRIVATELY THREATENED TO RESIGN, GOING SO FAR AS TO DRAFT A LETTER OF RESIGNATION THAT HE REPORTEDLY SHOWED TO VICE PRESIDENTS SANCHEZ

AND ALVA CASTRO AND PRIME MINISTER VILLANUEVA. HOW FAR THE PRESIDENT INTENDED TO CARRY THE THREAT IS UNCLEAR; HE SPIKED THE WHOLE MANEUVER THE DAY IT LEAKED TO THE PRESS, SEPTEMBER 8. COUP PARANOIA SURFACED IN SOME GOVERNMENT CIRCLES DURING THIS PERIOD; GARCIA INCLUDED A DENIAL THAT A COUP WAS IMMINENT IN HIS SEPTEMBER 8 STATEMENT. IN THE AFTERMATH OF THIS MINI-CRISIS, ATTENTION TURNED TO SORTING OUT WHAT HAD HAPPENED AND, AGAIN, TO THE PRESIDENT'S EMOTIONAL STABILITY.

4. NARCOTICS: ARMED STRIKE IN THE UHV AND UPROAR OVER ACQUITTAL OF NARCOTICS TRAFFICKER:

A LOOSE COALITION OF COCA GROWERS, TRAFFICKERS AND SENDERO LUMINOSO VIRTUALLY SHUT DOWN NORMAL ECONOMIC ACTIVITY IN THE UPPER HUALLAGA VALLEY AUGUST 19-24. THE PRO-SL "EL DIARIO" PROVIDED PROMINENT COVERAGE OF WHAT IT BILLED AS SL'S THIRD "ARMED STRIKE" IN LESS THAN A MONTH AND IN THE VALLEY SPREAD FLYERS THAT PROMOTED AND CLAIMED CREDIT FOR ITS ORGANIZATION. OPPOSITION TO POSSIBLE USE OF HERBICIDES WAS A FEATURE OF THE STRIKE. ROADS INTO AND THROUGH THE VALLEY WERE BLOCKED

JUSTICES AUGUST 8. SANCHEZ, FROM TRUJILLO, HAD  
BEEN CONVICTED IN 1980 AND SENTENCED TO 15 YEARS  
IMPRISONMENT FOR COCAINE TRAFFICKING. SANCHEZ  
THREW A HUGE PARTY AND PROMPTLY WENT UNDERGROUND.  
IN THE ENSUING POLITICAL UPROAR, A COALITION  
OF APRA, IU AND RIGHTIST PARTIES HELD A PROTEST  
RALLY IN TRUJILLO AND CONDEMNATION OF THE SUPREME  
COURT HAS BEEN FORTHCOMING FROM VITUALLY ALL  
QUARTERS. SUPREME COURT PRESIDENT MENDEZ OSBORN

THE ACQUITTAL (ON THE FIRST SET OF CHARGES) OF SL LEADER OSMAN MOROTE, THE SANCHEZ CASE HAS SUNK THE REPUTATION OF PERU'S JUDICIARY TO NEW DEPTHS. IT IS VAGUELY ENCOURAGING, HOWEVER, THAT THE PUBLIC REACTION HAS BEEN SO STRONG.

5. APRA POSTPONES ITS PARTY CONGRESS -- AGAIN:

APRA ANNOUNCED SEPTEMBER 10 THAT ITS PARTY CONGRESS IS BEING POSTPONED TO DECEMBER. EXACT DATES ARE STILL UNDECIDED. THE CONGRESS WAS ORIGINALLY SET FOR AUGUST AND WAS THEN DELAYED UNTIL OCTOBER. NO REASONS FOR THE NEW POSTPONEMENT WERE GIVEN, BUT APRA SOURCES TELL US THE MOST IMPORTANT IS CONFLICT BETWEEN NATIONAL AND PROVINCIAL LEADERSHIP OVER THE ACCURACY OF PARTY MEMBERSHIP REGISTERS, ON WHICH THE SIZE OF DELEGATIONS TO THE 1500-DELEGATE NATIONAL CONGRESS WILL BE BASED. SAY THE DELAY FAVORS THE PRESIDENT; ALVA CASTRO SUPPORTERS SEEM UNDISTURBED. NOW THAT HE IS JUST A RANK AND FILE DEPUTY, ALVA CASTRO IS HAVING SOME DIFFICULTY, HOWEVER, KEEPING HIS NAME IN THE NEWS (HE KEEPS DROPPING IN PRESIDENTIAL POLLS). TO COMPENSATE, ALVA HAS RECENTLY PUBLISHED TWO BOOKS -- ONE ON HAYA DE LA TORRE, THE OTHER ON FOUNDING PARTY MEMBER MANUEL SEONE, WHO DIED 25 YEARS AGO. BOTH BOOKS ARE COMPILATIONS OF ARTICLES BY HAYA AND SEONE AND WERE CLEARLY SLAPPED TOGETHER HASTILY. THEY WERE FINANCED BY ALVA'S BUDDY ENRIQUE MIRANDA, OWNER OF DEZA PUBLISHERS. AT THE PRESENTATION OF THE SECOND BOOK SEPTEMBER 10, ALVA HAD OLD GUARDISTS LUIS ALBERTO SANCHEZ AND FERNANDO LEON DE VIVERO ON THE PODIUM WITH HIM. ALSO PRESENT WAS THE NEW MINISTER OF ENERGY AND MINES, JOSE CARRASCO TAVARA. CARRASCO HAD PUBLICLY SUPPORTED ALVA IN HIS CONFLICT WITH GARCIA IN JUNE 1987, BUT ADVOCATED GARCIA'S RE-ELECTION IN A STATEMENT IN OCTOBER 1987.

RADICALLY LEFTIST OF THE UNITED LEFT COALITION, BARELY SURVIVED A SPLIT BETWEEN ITS RADICAL AND LESS RADICAL FACTIONS IN LATE AUGUST. THE QUARREL (OVER POWER WITHIN THE PARTY, BUT WITH POLITICAL STRATEGY THE OSTENSIBLE ISSUE) APPEARS PATCHED UP FOR THE MOMENT. FORMER IU PARTY PRESIDENT ALFONSO BARRANTES HAS LATELY KEPT A LOW PROFILE, BUT WENT ON TELEVISION SEPTEMBER 11 TO CRITICIZE THE GOP ECONOMIC PACKAGE FOR ITS EFFECT ON THE POOR. BEEN NO MAJOR INCIDENTS SINCE THE LARGE BLACKOUT AT THE END OF JULY. OUTSIDE LIMA, HOWEVER, SL CONTINUES TO KEEP THE HEAT ON, PARTICULARLY IN THE AYACUCHO EMERGENCY ZONE AND THE CENTRAL SIERRA DEPARTMENTS OF JUNIN AND CERRO DE PASCO. IN APURIMAC (AYACUCHO EZ), SL PULLED OFF ITS SECOND "ARMED STRIKE" IN A PERIOD OF A FEW WEEKS, EFFECTIVELY SHUTTING DOWN ECONOMIC ACTIVITY IN ANDAHUAYLAS THE MIDDLE OF AUGUST. SL FOLLOWED UP WITH ANOTHER SUCH STRIKE IN THE UHV (SEE PARA 4). ON SEPTEMBER 9, THE PRESS PUBLISHED A PHOTO OF RETIRED GENERAL JERI GARCIA, KIDNAPPED JULY 7, IN FRONT OF AN MRTA BANNER AND ON SEPTEMBER 11 A LIMA TV CHANNEL PLAYED A TAPE FROM JERI CONFIRMING THAT MRTA IS HOLDING HIM FOR RANSOM. THE CONGRESS IS ABOUT READY TO DEBATE THE ANTI-TERRORIST LEGISLATION THE PRESIDENT PROPOSED JULY 27. THE PRESIDENT HAD ASKED THAT IT BE APPROVED IN 15 DAYS. THE LEGISLATION FACES DIFFICULTY, AS JUSTICE MINISTRY ADVISERS AND OTHERS SAY IT WAS SLOPPILY AND HASTILY DRAWN UP BY THE INTERIOR MINISTRY. SL LEADER MOROTE IS INTO HIS SECOND TRIAL, WHICH IS GETTING LESS PUBLICITY THAN THE FIRST. MOROTE HAS SEVERAL TIMES REFUSED TO APPEAR IN COURT AND APPARENTLY GOTTEN AWAY WITH IT.
