1. (U) SUMMARY: DEFENSE MINISTER JORGE TORRES TOLD THE PERUVIAN PRESS SEPTEMBER 9 THAT THE NEW BILATERAL MILITARY AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. HAD NOT YET BEEN SIGNED, BUT THAT HE HOPED IT WOULD BE. HE DENIED THAT THE AGREEMENT WOULD BRING U.S. TROOPS TO PERU, EXCEPT AS TRAINERS. THE SIGNING OF THE MILITARY AID PACKAGE WAS INCLUDED AS A "MINOR ISSUE" IN WIDE-RANGING INTERVIEWS WHICH PRIMARILY FOCUSED ON ARMY CORRUPTION, HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS, AND ILLEGAL WIRETAPS. AID AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES. GENERAL (RET.) TORRES DID NOT SPECULATE, HOWEVER, AS TO WHETHER THE AGREEMENT WOULD ACTUALLY BE SIGNED. THE COMMENT APPEARED IN INTERVIEWS APPEARING IN LEFTIST DAILY "LA REPUBLICA" AND WEEKLY NEWS MAGAZINE "SI".

- 3. (U) TORRES NOTED THAT THE GOVERNMENT HAD NOT YET SIGNED THE AGREEMENT, BUT THAT HE "SAW NOTHING BAD IN IT." HE PROMISED "ABSOLUTELY" THAT THE AGREEMENT WOULD NOT PERMIT THE PRESENCE OF U.S. TROOPS IN PERU, EXCEPT FOR TRAINING PURPOSES, AND ONLY "SO LONG AS THEY DO NOT INTERVENE DIRECTLY." HE ALSO DENIED THAT THE AGREEMENT INCLUDED THE SPECIFIC MENTION OF THE SALE OF HELICOPTERS TO PERU.
- 4. (U) THE DEFENSE MINSTER CHARACTERIZED THE PENDING AGREEMENT AS INTENDED TO BATTLE THE TWIN PLAGUES OF NARCO-TRAFFICKING AND SUBVERSION. BUT HE ALSO PROMISED THAT THE GOP WOULD NOT ABANDON ITS COMMITMENT TO DEVELOP ECONOMIC ALTERNATIVES TO COCA CULTIVATION EVEN WHILE IT PURSUED AN AGGRESSIVE ANTI-TERRORISM/SUBVERSION EFFORT.
- 5. (U) BOTH WEEKEND INTERVIEWS COVERED A WIDE VARIETY OF SUBJECTS. THE QUESTION OF THE MILITARY AGREEMENT WAS ACTUALLY SECONDARY TO ISSUES OF ARMY CORRUPTION, HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS, AND THE STATE OF HEALTH OF THE GOP'S ANTI-SUBVERSION STRUGGLE. RESPONDING LIKE A SEASONED POLITICIAN, TORRES ADROITLY SIDESTEPPED POINTED QUESTIONS ON NARCOTICS

(C) THE INTERVIEWING JOURNALISTS TRIED, BUT WERE UNABLE, TO SCORE ANY DIRECT BLOW AGAINST THE SLIPPERY TORRES ACIEGO. THE PRINCIPAL ITEM ON THE DEFENSE MINISTER'S AGENDA APPEARED TO BE TO ATTEMPT TO DISTANCE THE MILITARY FROM CHARGES THAT THE NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE SERVICE (SIN) HAS BEEN EAVESDROPPING ON THOUSANDS OF CONVERSATIONS OF DOZENS OF POLITICAL AND MILITARY FIGURES DURING THE PAST SEVERAL YEARS.
