- (U) THE TUPAC AMARU REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENT (MRTA) MARKED THE SEVENTH ANNIVERSARY OF ITS ARMED STRUGGLE WITH A MORTAR ATTACK AGAINST THE PRESIDENTIAL PALACE EARLY ON NOVEMBER 5. THIS FOLLOWED A SPATE OF DYNAMITE ATTACKS IN VARIOUS PARTS OF LIMA LATE ON NOVEMBER 4 (THE ACTUAL ANNIVERSARY DATE) AGAINST 12 BANKS, THE MAIN OFFICE OF THE GOP SUPERINTENDENCY OF BANKING AND INSURANCE AND AN OFFICE OF THE GOVERNMENT WATER MONOPOLY "SEDAPAL." AT LEAST SIX PERSONS WERE INJURED IN THE ATTACKS. MEDIA REPORTS INDICATE THAT FOUR PERSONS WERE INJURED BY ONE BOMB WHICH DESTROYED A TELLER MACHINE IN THE BUSY NIGHT DISTRICT OF MIRAFLORES.
- (U) ACCORDING TO POLICE SOURCES, TWO 60 MM MORTAR ROUNDS WERE FIRED AT THE PALACE BUT LANDED WIDE. TWO POLICE SERGEANTS GUARDING THE PALACE WERE WOUNDED. A PALACE PRESS AIDE SAID THAT EXPLOSIVE ROUNDS HIT NEAR THE BACK ENTRANCE OF THE PALACE AND DAMAGED SEVERAL VEHICLES.
