2. (U) A RECENT NATIONAL POLL INDICATES PERUVIAN PRESIDENT FUJIMORI WILL NOT WIN THE SIMPLE MAJORITY NEEDED FOR A FIRST-ROUND ELECTION VICTORY ON APRIL 9; HE RECEIVED ONLY 38 PERCENT OF THE POLL VOTE, AND ALEJANDRO TOLEDO OBTAINED 27 PERCENT, ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS. THE SAME POLL PREDICTED NEARLY A DEAD HEAT IN A SECOND ROUND, WITH TOLEDO AHEAD BY ONE PERCENTAGE POINT.
