1. (C) SUMMARY: PRESIDENT FUJIMORI HAS NOW MADE HIS BREAK WITH FORMER EX-INTELLIGENCE ADVISOR VLADIMIRO MONTESINOS PUBLIC IN A DRAMATIC, PERSUASIVE WAY. HE AUTHORIZED GOP NEGOTIATORS TO REMOVE THE LINKAGE BETWEEN MILITARY AMNESTY AND NEW ELECTIONS. BOTH ACTIONS GAVE THE OAS TALKS A MUCH-NEEDED ELEMENT OF CONFIDENCE AND FACILITATED A MAJOR BREAKTHROUGH OCTOBER 25. POLITICAL TENSIONS HAVE EASED AND THE OPPOSITION HAS AGREED TO RETURN TO CONGRESS. END SUMMARY

AUTHORIZED HIS NEGOTIATORS TO DROP THE LINKAGE BETWEEN MILITARY AMNESTY AND NEW ELECTIONS, AND THE OPPOSITION AGREED TO PUT RECONCILIATION (WHICH ALSO INCLUDES THE AMNESTY ISSUE) FORMALLY ON THE OAS AGENDA. 4. (SBU) THE OPERATION ITSELF WAS UNSUCCESSFUL. PRESIDENT
FUJIMORI TOLD THE PRESS THAT HE HAD NOT ISSUED A WARRANT FOR
MONTESINOS'S ARREST BUT OPERATIONS IN FIVE LOCATIONS WERE
UNDERWAY TO FIND MONTESINOS. THE SEARCH WOULD CONTINUE DAY AND

COORDINADORA FILED CHARGES LAST YEAR AGAINST MONTESINOS FOR
GENOCIDE. NONE OF THESE CASES WAS RECOMMENDED FOR PROSECUTION
IN EARLIER INVESTIGATIONS.
