
- EMBASSY DAO IS FORWARDING SEPARATELY A COPY OF THE PERUVIAN ARMY'S "DOCTRINE ON INTERNAL DEFENSE" (DIT) WHICH IS TAUGHT TO SECOND-YEAR WAR COLLEGE STUDENTS. THE ACTIONS OF THE GOP, INCLUDING THE CURRENT TROOP MOVEMENTS, TRACK VERY CLOSELY WITH THIS DOCTRINE. ACCORDING TO THE DIT, THE FIRST PHASE OF DEFENSE AGAINST CIVIL INSURRECTION IS PREVENTATIVE AND IS UNDER THE CONT ROL OF POLICE AUTHORITIES. IF THE PREVENTATIVE FAILS TO RESTROE ORDER IN THE AFFECTED AREA, THE PLAN CALLS FOR A "REPRESSIVE" PHASE UNDER A STATE OF EMERGENCY OR STATE OF SIEGE. 

THE EARLY HOURS OF THE 27TH, AND SET FIRE TO ITS CONTENTS. THE MAYOR OF THE SAME TOWN (150 KILOMETERS FROM AYACUCHO CITY) WAS KILLED BY TERRORISTS ON DECEMBER 25. ALSO ON DECEMBER 27, IN LA MAR PROVINCE'S SAN MIGUEL, TERRORISTS DYNAMITED A WATER CONDUIT FOR THE LOCAL HYDRO-ELECTRIC PLANT, KNOCKING OUT THE AREA'S ELECTRICAL SUPPLY. THE CIVIL GUARD (CG) IN AYACUCHO REPORTED AN ATTACK ON ITS POST AT HUANCAPI IN VICTOR FAJARDO ON THE MORNING OF THE 27TH, PRIOR TO THE TROOP MOVEMENTS AND CLAIMED ONLY ONE GC WAS WOUNDED IN THE SUCCESSFUL DEFENSE OF THE POST.
