2. BARRETO ALSO STATED THAT SOME 2,637 PERSONS WERE "DETAINED" FOR SUSPECTED INVOLVEMENT WITH TERRORISM. ((COMMENT: THIS FIGURE, HOWEVER, PROBABLY REFERS TO ALL PERSONS PICKED UP ON TERRORIST CHARGES, WITHOUT REFERENCE TO THOSE SUBSEQUENTLY RELEASED FOR LACK OF EVIDENCE. FIGURES MADE PUBLIC BY PERUVINA PRISON AUTHORITIES IN LATE JUNE CITED 658 PERSONS OFFICIALLY "DETAINED" IN OVER A DOZEN WIDELY SEPARATED PRISONS. END COMMENT.))
