THAT ONE OF THE FUNDAMENTAL PURPOSES OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES IS TO PROMOTE AND CONSOLIDATE REPRESENTATIVE DEMOCRACY WITH DUE RESPECT FOR THE PRINCIPLE OF NON-INTERVENTION; AND

THAT THE SOLIDARITY OF THE AMERICAN STATES AND THE HIGH AIMS WHICH ARE SOUGHT THROUGH IT REQUIRE THE POLITICAL ORGANIZATION OF THESE STATES ON THE BASIS OF THE EFFECTIVE EXERCISE OF REPRESENTATIVE DEMOCRACY; AND

CONSIDERING:

THAT THE EVENTS WHICH OCCURRED IN PERU SERIOUSLY AFFECT THE INSTITUTIONAL ORDER AND ALTER THE EXERCISE OF REPRESENTATIVE DEMOCRACY IN A MEMBER STATE OF THE ORGANIZATION.

RESOLVES:

(1) TO RATIFY IN ALL ITS TERMS THE RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE PERMANENT COUNCIL IN THE SESSION OF APRIL 6, 1992 (CP/RES. 579 (879/92)).

(2) TO ISSUE A CALL FOR THE REESTABLISHMENT OF THE DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONAL ORDER IN PERU AND FOR AN END TO ALL ACTION THAT AFFECTS THE EXERCISE OF HUMAN RIGHTS, AVOIDING THE ADOPTION OF NEW MEASURES THAT COULD AGGRAVATE THE SITUATION.

(3) TO URGE THE PERUVIAN AUTHORITIES TO CARRY OUT THE EARLY RELEASE OF THE LEGISLATORS AND POLITICAL AND LABOR

LEADERS WHO WERE DEPRIVED OF THEIR LIBERTY IN THESE CIRCUMSTANCES, ENSURING THEM THE EXERCISE OF THEIR RIGHT TO MOVE ABOUT WITHOUT ANY RESTRICTIONS ON THEIR PERSONAL LIBERTY.

(4) TO EXPRESS ITS PROFOUND CONCERN OVER THE CURRENT SITUATION OF NON-ADHERENCE TO CIVIL RIGHTS AND PUBLIC FREEDOMS IN PERU AND TO REQUEST THE AUTHORITIES TO GUARANTEE FULL RESPECT AND EXERCISE OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS TO MEET AND TO ASSOCIATE, FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION OF THOUGHT, AND FREEDOM OF THE PRESS.

(5) TO REQUEST THE SECRETARY GENERAL, TOGETHER WITH THE CHAIRMAN OF THE AD HOC MEETING OF FOREIGN MINISTERS, TO PROMOTE EFFORTS (WITH THE PERUVIAN AUTHORITIES) FOR THE PURPOSE OF BEGINNING A DIALOGUE WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF THE POLITICAL FORCES REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATIVE POWER (REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH) DESIGNED TO CREATE A CLIMATE OF ACCORD AND TO ESTABLISH THE CONDITIONS AND THE COMMITMENT AMONG THE PARTIES FOR THE REESTABLISHMENT OF REPRESENTATIVE DEMOCRACY IN PERU, WITH FULL RESPECT FOR THE PRINCIPLE OF THE SEPARATION OF POWERS AND FOR HUMAN RIGHTS UNDER THE RULE OF LAW.

(6) TO KEEP OPEN THE AD HOC MEETING OF MINISTERS OF FOREIGN RELATIONS AND TO RECEIVE IN IT THE REPORT OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL REGARDING THE EFFORTS REFERRED TO IN THE FIFTH PARAGRAPH OF THIS RESOLUTION.

(7) TO ENTRUST TO THE SECRETARY GENERAL THE TASK OF KEEPING THE MINISTERS OF FOREIGN RELATIONS INFORMED, THROUGH THE PERMANENT COUNCIL, ABOUT EFFORTS UNDERTAKEN.

SUBJECT: DRAFT RESOLUTION ON PERU FOR OAS MEETING OF FOREIGN MINISTERS APRIL 13

FROM USOAS

1. A "FIRST-DRAFT" OF A RESOLUTION ON PERU FOR ADOPTION.

AT THE APRIL 13 OAS MEETING OF FOREIGN MINISTERS (TEXT IN PARA 2 BELOW) WAS CIRCULATED AT THE OAS APRIL 9 BY ARGENTINE AMBASSADOR PATINO MEYER IN THE NAME OF "A GROUP OF SOUTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES." PATINO MADE CLEAR HE HAD NOT WRITTEN THE DRAFT HIMSELF AND THAT IT WAS OFFERED AS A CONSTRUCTIVE OPENING MOVE, DEFINITELY MORE PALATABLE TO MOST MEMBERS THAN A HARSH AND PUNITIVE DRAFT CIRCULATED YESTERDAY BY COSTA RICA. THIS MISSION AGREES THAT IT IS A POTENTIALLY USEFUL STARTING POINT.

THE RESOLUTION OF THE PERMANENT COUNCIL OF APRIL 6, 1992, BY WHICH AN AD HOC MEETING OF MINISTERS OF FOREIGN RELATIONS WAS CONVOKED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION AG/RES. 1080 (XXI-0/91);

HAVING HEARD:

THE STATEMENT OF THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN RELATIONS OF PERU ON THE GRAVE SITUATION EXISTING IN HIS COUNTRY, AND EVENTS THAT HAVE OCCURRED THERE;

REAFFIRMING:
