Notes: As a result of the suspension of constitutional rights and the self-imposed military coup of President Fujimoro, all U.S. military aid to Peru has been suspended.

All new applications involving Peru should be returned without action. Those applications that had already been staffed at the time of this notice can stay in the system. However, no approvals for any type of license request for Peru will be granted until further notice. Disapprovals for standard reasons -- foreign policy, national security, etc. -- are authorized. This policy regarding commercial exports is a PM-instituted action and there is no embargo on Peru cases.

LOs should be sensitive to the narcotics trafficking problem as well as to the existence of two particularly violent and active terrorist groups: Sandero Luminoso and the MRTA.
