1. PERU: SL BOMBINGS CAUSE HIGH CASUALTIES. (U)  
A. ~~(C)~~ ON 16 JULY, SHINING PATH (SL) TERRORISTS DETONATED  
MULTIPLE CAR BOMBS IN THE CENTER OF LIMA'S EXCLUSIVE  
MIRAFLORES DISTRICT. EIGHTEEN PEOPLE WERE KILLED AND 200  
WERE INJURED BY THE POWERFUL EXPLOSIONS, ALTHOUGH THE NUMBER

OF VICTIMS MAY STILL INCREASE'

B. ~~(C)~~ THE BLASTS WERE CAUSED BY AN ESTIMATED 300-350 KILOS OF DYNAMITE AND AMMONIUM NITRATE FUEL OIL (ANFO) MIXTURE' THE BOMBS EXPLODED WITHIN MINUTES ON THE SAME BLOCK AND DAMAGED THE NEARBY U.S. CONSULATE' THREE U.S. GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL, WHO WERE LODGED IN AREA HOTELS, WERE SLIGHTLY INJURED IN THE EXPLOSIONS. ALSO ON 16 JULY, THE SL SIMULTANEOUSLY ATTACKED FOUR POLICE STATIONS AND PLACED A CAR BOMB AT ANOTHER POLICE STATION, INJURING AT LEAST NINE POLICEMEN. WHILE ATTACKING THE POLICE STATIONS, OTHER SL MEMBERS BLACKED OUT PARTS OF LIMA BY DOWNING HIGH-TENSION POWER PYLONS AROUND THE CITY.

C. (U) IN RELATED INCIDENTS, THE SL BURNED A FACTORY AND BOMBED TWO LOCAL BANKS IN LIMA ON 19 JULY. A WITNESS TO ONE OF THE BANK ATTACKS STATED THAT THE SL WAS DISTRIBUTING FLYERS WHICH CALLED FOR AN "ARMED STRIKE" ON 23 AND 24 JULY.

D. ~~(C)~~ COMMENT: THE MASSIVE CAR BOMBINGS SUGGEST THAT THE SL MAY BE ADOPTING A NEW "MASS CASUALTY" TACTIC IN THEIR BOMBING CAMPAIGNS. THE WAVE OF ATTACKS MAY ALSO BE AN ATTEMPT BY THE GROUP TO SHOW THAT RECENT POLICE CRACKDOWNS HAVE NOT SERIOUSLY HINDERED THEIR ABILITY TO OPERATE IN LIMA. THE ATTACKS, AS WELL AS THE CALL FOR AN ARMED STRIKE ON 23-24 JULY, MAY ALSO SIGNAL THE BEGINNING OF AN NEW SL CAMPAIGN IN PREPARATION FOR PERU'S 28 JULY INDEPENDENCE DAY.

2. (U) WORLDWIDE: TERRORISM NOTES.

A. (U) ISRAEL: THE ISRAELI GENERAL SECURITY SERVICE IS INVESTIGATING A POSSIBLE THREAT TO THE U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE FROM A RIGHT-WING ISRAELI GROUP. DURING THE SECRETARY'S JULY VISIT, ISRAELI POLICE WILL FOCUS THEIR ATTENTION ON TWO RIGHT-WING GROUPS: KAKH AND KAHANA HAY. DURING THE SECRETARY'S PREVIOUS VISITS KAKH SABOTAGED U.S. BUILDINGS AND INSTITUTIONS IN JERUSALEM, CAUSING MINOR DAMAGE TO SEVERAL STRUCTURES. ADDITIONALLY, POLICE ARE CONCERNED THAT THERE MAY BE A CONNECTION BETWEEN THE THEFT OF THREE ROCKET-PROPELLED GRENADE LAUNCHERS FROM AN ISRAELI AMMUNITION SITE AND THE VISIT OF THE U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE.

B. (U) KUWAIT: ACCORDING TO THE KUWAITI INTERIOR MINISTRY, FIVE AGENTS IN THE EMPLOY OF THE IRAQI INTELLIGENCE SERVICE WERE ARRESTED ON 19 JULY. KUWAITI AUTHORITIES FOUND EXPLOSIVES, INCLUDING 240 HAND GRENADES, AND DOCUMENTS THAT LINKED THE FIVE TO THE IRAQI INTELLIGENCE SERVICE. THE GROUP CONSISTED OF ONE KUWAITI, THREE IRAQIS AND ONE PALESTINIAN. THE LEADER OF THE GROUP CONFESSED TO PLACING THE BOMB NEAR THE HOME OF THE DEAN OF KUWAIT'S MEDICAL COLLEGE ON 25 JUNE WHICH KILLED AN IRANIAN GARDENER, AND TO THE FIREBOMBING OF AN ARTS CENTER.

C. ~~(C/NE/WN)~~ ISRAEL/LIBYA: ACCORDING TO THE TERRORIST CAPTURED BY THE ISRAELIS DURING THE 30 MAY ATTEMPT TO ATTACK EILAT, HIS THREE-MAN SQUAD -- TOGETHER WITH OTHER MEMBERS OF FATAH'S WESTERN SECTOR ORGANIZATION -- WAS TRANSFERRED FROM LIBYA TO YEMEN ON THE ORDERS OF MOHAMMED AL-MADANI IN DECEMBER. FROM THAT TIME UNTIL MID-MAY, THE GROUP CONTINUED TO CONDUCT TRAINING AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN YEMEN. THE GROUP WAS VISITED SEVERAL TIMES BY SENIOR MEMBERS OF THE WESTERN SECTOR ORGANIZATION, TO INCLUDE MADANI. ON 19 MAY, THE THREE-MAN SQUAD FLEW FROM YEMEN TO TUNIS AND THEN CROSSED

OVERLAND INTO TRIPOLI. THE GROUP RECEIVED THEIR FINAL MISSION BRIEF FROM MADANI PRIOR TO THEIR DEPARTURE ON 25 MAY FROM LIBYA OVERLAND TO EGYPT ENROUTE TO JORDAN. THE CIRCUITOUS ROUTES WERE NECESSATED BY THE UN CIVIL AIR EMBARGO IMPOSED ON LIBYA.

D. ~~(C/NF/WN/NO)~~ COLOMBIA: THE NATIONAL LIBERATION ARMY (ELN) REPORTEDLY HAS ORDERED BOMBING ATTACKS AGAINST SEVERAL MULTINATIONAL AND U.S. COMPANIES IN BOGOTA AND POSSIBLY MEDELLIN DURING THE 18-26 JULY TIME PERIOD. THE GROUP APPARENTLY DOES NOT INTEND TO TARGET U'S. EMBASSY PERSONNEL AT THIS TIME. THE ATTACKS ARE BELIEVED TO BE PART OF AN ELN EFFORT TO GARNER MEDIA ATTENTION.

E. (U) TURKEY: UNIDENTIFIED TERRORISTS SHOT AND KILLED A POLICE OFFICER IN THE ABDINPASA DISTRICT OF ANKARA ON 16 JULY. THE ASSAILANTS ESCAPED. ON THE SAME DAY, TERRORISTS HURLED FIREBOMBS AT A TURKISH COMPANY'S FACILITY IN ANKARA CAUSING EXTENSIVE DAMAGE. THE DEV SOL TERRORIST GROUP IS SUSPECTED OF CONDUCTING BOTH INCIDENTS.

F. (U) TURKEY: ON 18 JULY, KURDISTAN WORKER'S PARTY (PKK) MILITANTS RAIDED THE KELEPCI VILLAGE IN DICILE, DIYARBAKIR, KILLING THREE PERSONS AND INJURING AT LEAST THREE' OVER THE WEEKEND, TURKISH SECURITY FORCES IN ADANA ARRESTED FOURTEEN PKK MILITANTS SUSPECTED OF INVOLVEMENT IN RECENT TERRORIST INCIDENTS. DURING THE ARRESTS AUTHORITIES SEIZED TWO CHINESE-MADE AK-47S, THREE PISTOLS, AMMUNITION, HAND GRENADES AND A RADIO.

G. (U) INDIA: THE BOMBAY POLICE ARRESTED MANJIT SINGH, A SIKH MILITANT LEADER, AT THE DADAR RAILWAY STATION ON 18 JULY. AUTHORITIES BELIEVE THAT THE 33-YEAR-OLD MILITANT WAS INVOLVED IN THE BOMBING OF AN AIR INDIA FLIGHT IN JUNE 1985. THE BOMB DETONATED OVER THE IRISH COAST, CLAIMING THE LIVES OF ALL 329 PASSENGERS AND CREW. THE U.S. HAS ISSUED AN ARREST WARRANT IN CONNECTION WITH THE 1985 BOMBING FOR A LAL SINGH, AN ALIAS USED BY MANJIT SINGH. IT IS NOT YET CLEAR IF THIS BOMBAY SUSPECT IS THE SAME PERSON IDENTIFIED IN THE U'S. ARREST WARRANT.
