OF HUMAN RIGHTS PRIORITY CASES TO THEIR CONTACTS, INCLUDING DCM'S CALL ON MOD HUMAN RIGHTS COORDINATOR, GENERAL ARCINIEGA. MOREOVER, WE INTEND TO SHARE OUR UNCLASSIFIED RESPONSES TO CONGRESSIONAL INQUIRIES ON HUMAN RIGHTS WITH GOP MILITARY AND CIVILIAN AGENCIES TO KEEP THE PRESSURE ON THEM. END SUMMARY.

3. AMBASSADOR CALLED ON ACTING VICE FOREIGN MINISTER ARMANDO LECAROS MARCH 22 TO ADDRESS THE ISSUE OF HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS IN PERU. AMBASSADOR OPENED THE DISCUSSION BY PRESENTING LECAROS WITH EMBASSY'S SPANISH LANGUAGE LISTS OF PRIORITY CASES INVOLVING ALLEGATIONS OF MILITARY OR POLICE SPONSORED "DISAPPEARANCES," TORTURE, RAPES OR OTHER GROSS ABUSES (SEE PARAS 10-14.)

4. LECAROS QUESTIONED THE RELIABILITY OF SOME OF THE SOURCES OF INFORMATION USED IN COMPILING THE LISTS, NOTABLY AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL AND AMERICAS WATCH. THE AMBASSADOR REPLIED THAT MANY OF THESE CASES WERE WELL-KNOWN IN PERU AND IN WASHINGTON, THAT THE EMBASSY HAD DONE ITS OWN INVESTIGATIONS INTO MANY OF THESE CASES AND THAT, IN ANY EVENT, THIS WAS A CHANCE FOR THE GOP EITHER TO PROVE ITS DETRACTORS WRONG ON THE FACTS OR TO PRODUCE RESULTS WHICH CAN BE POINTED TO AS SIGNS OF PROGRESS.

5. AMBASSADOR ADDED THAT IT CANNOT BE DENIED THAT ABUSES HAVE OCCURRED AND THAT THE ISSUE IS CAUSE FOR GREAT CONCERN IN WASHINGTON, NOT ONLY IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH BUT ON BOTH SIDES OF THE AISLE IN CONGRESS AS WELL. TO THE EXTENT THE GOP CAN

PROPER AUTHORITIES IN THE DEFENSE, INTERIOR, JUSTICE AND PUBLIC (I.E., ATTORNEY GENERAL) MINISTRIES. AMBASSADOR EMPHASIZED THAT IF THE CHARGES WERE SUBSTANTIATED CORRECTIVE MEASURES MUST BE TAKEN AND THAT WE INTEND TO MONITOR THE CASES. LECAROS HAD NO OBJECTION TO DIRECT APPROACHES TO THE MILITARY, INCLUDING ARMY GENERAL ALBERTO ARCINIEGA, NOW IN CHARGE OF HUMAN RIGHTS FOR THE COMANDO CONJUNTO. LECAROS CONCLUDED BY AGREEING THAT IMPROVEMENTS MUST BE MADE IN THE FIELD OF HUMAN RIGHTS, BUT THAT IT WOULD BE QUITE DIFFICULT.

DCM AND HUMAN RIGHTS OFFICER WILL CALL ON MOD HUMAN RIGHTS COORDINATOR, GENERAL ARCINIEGA, THIS COMING WEEK, AND PROVIDE HIM WITH THE SAME LISTS. THE LISTS WILL ALSO BE SHARED WITH INTERIOR, JUSTICE AND PUBLIC MINISTRY OFFICIALS, AS WELL AS DAO, MAAG, DEA AND CONTACTS OF OTHER MISSION ELEMENTS, AS APPROPRIATE. ANGEL ESCOBAR JURADO, PRESIDENT OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS COMMITTEE OF HUANCVELICA, WAS LAST SEEN BEING DETAINED ON THE STREET OUTSIDE OF HIS OFFICE BY FIVE OR SIX MEN, 7 PM ON 6 FEBRUARY 27, 1990. THE MEN HAD PREVIOUSLY ENQUIRED AT ESCOBAR'S HOUSE AS TO HIS WHEREABOUTS. WITNESSES TESTIFIED THAT SOME OF THE MEN WERE KNOWN MILITARY PERSONNEL.

JAVIER ALARCON, PROFESSOR AT THE NATIONAL ENGINEERING UNIVERSITY, AND A DIRECTOR OF THE CGTP LABOR FEDERATION, DISAPPEARED DECEMBER 15, 1989, ON THE ROAD BETWEEN ORROYA AND HUANCAYO, JUNIN DEPARTMENT.

RAFAEL ANTONIO NAVARRO WAS DETAINED IN HIS HOUSE IN HUANCAYO AT 10:30 PM, FEBRUARY 7, 1990, BY HOODED MEN, DRESSED IN MILITARY CLOTHES AND CARRYING MILITARY-ISSUE RIFLES. HE WAS TAKEN FROM THE HOUSE, PUT IN A 4X4 TRUCK AND TAKEN OFF IN THE DIRECTION OF THE MILITARY CUARTEL (A BLOCK AND A HALF AWAY); HIS CAPTORS FIRING INTO THE AIR. IT IS KNOWN THAT HE WAS SEEN ALIVE IN THE MILITARY CUARTEL AT JAUJA AND THAT HE WAS LATER TRANSFERRED TO THE CUARTEL "9 DE DICIEMBRE" IN HUANCAYO.
