The Embassy of Peru presents its compliments to the Honorable Department of State and would like to inform that as a consequence of the capture of the leader of the terrorist group Shining Path, Abimael Guzman, the Government of Peru has detected the possibility that some activist and supporters of the above mentioned terrorist group could develop some activities against the Peruvian agencies abroad.

In this regard, the Embassy of Peru request the kind intervention of the Department of State to take the proper security measures to assure the safety of this Embassy, the Residence of the Ambassador, the Residence of the Chargé d'Affaires a.i., as well as the offices of the Consulates General in the United States, the offices of the Naval, Air and Military Attaché's and the Peruvian Missions in Washington, D.C., and New York.

This Embassy would like to inform the Department that today some graffiti's were found in the main entrance of our Mission at the United Nations in New York and yesterday a group of supporters of the Shining Path held a manifestation in the city of San Francisco.
