WHO FLED THE AREAS; PRIEST DENIED KNOWLEDGE, AND SAID THAT IN ANY CASE HE WOULD SEND ANYONE WITH INFORMATION TO THE CANADIAN EMBASSY, "SINCE WE ARE CANADIANS HERE." THE PROSECUTORS SPOKE OF THE EXHUMATION OF BODIES AT CAYUMBA CHICO, BUT NEITHER THEY NOR THE JOURNALISTS WERE AWARE OF ANY BOMBARDMENT. BOTH TENDED TO BLAME ANY DEATHS ON SENDERO. WHILE EMBOFF WAS PRESENT, PROSECUTOR ON DUTY RECEIVED CALL FROM ATTORNEY GENERAL COLAN INSTRUCTING HIM TO INVESTIGATE, AT THE REQUEST OF THE ARMY, INCIDENTS IN MOYUNA AND MOENA. CALL OCCURRED SHORTLY AFTER CHARGE ASKED COLAN TO INVESTIGATE THE HUANUCO KILLINGS. LIMA PRESS BILLED THE NAS VISIT AS INTENDED FOR INVESTIGATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS. END SUMMARY

SHARED LITTLE OF WHAT THEY HAD BEEN TOLD; THEY WERE UNWILLING TO ASK ANY OF THE WITNESSES WITH WHOM THEY HAD SPOKEN IF THEY WOULD BE INTERESTED IN SPEAKING WITH A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE EMBASSY. THEY SAID THERE WERE MANY WITNESSES WHO HAD FLED TO ANDA, 45 MINUTES AND THREE CONTROL POINTS AWAY ON THE MARGINAL HIGHWAY, WHO HAD BEEN SPEAKING FREELY TO JOURNALISTS, REPRESENTATIVES OF HUMAN RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS AND THE ICRC. 7. GONZALES LEFT IN THE MIDDLE OF THE INTERVIEW TO TAKE A CALL FROM LIMA, IN WHICH THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, BLANCA NELIDA COLAN, INSTRUCTED HIM TO INVESTIGATE REPORTS OF 13 DEATHS AT MOENA AND MOYUNA. HER CALL CAME SHORTLY AFTER CHARGE AND POLOFF HAD MET WITH HER TO URGE INVESTIGATION OF THE HUANUCO ALLEGATIONS. THE ARMY REQUESTED THE INVESTIGATION AND WILL PROVIDE HELICOPTER ACCESS, HE SAID. EMBOFF ASKED WHY ONLY THE CAYUMBA CHICO INCIDENT HAD BEEN INVESTIGATED, DESPITE THE FACT THAT PEOPLE IN THE STREET WERE TALKING ABOUT OTHER DEATHS. IS THE PROSECUTOR REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO INVESTIGATE SOMETHING? GONZALES FIRST DENIED KNOWING ANYTHING ABOUT OTHER INCIDENTS BEFORE READING THE COPY OF THE LIMA ISSUE OF "LA REPUBLICA" OF APRIL 20 PRESENTED TO HIM AT THE INTERVIEW (NOTE: THE TINGO MARIA ISSUE DID NOT REPORT THE INCIDENTS). HE ALSO SAID THAT HE WAS UNABLE TO INVESTIGATE EVERYTHING HE HEARD BECAUSE PROSECUTORS DO NOT HAVE OFFICIAL VEHICLES OR SECURITY, AND HAVE TO USE THEIR OWN VEHICLES. HE THEN COMPLAINED BITTERLY THAT WITNESSES DID NOT COME DIRECTLY TO THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE IN TINGO MARIA WITH INFORMATION, BUT WENT INSTEAD TO LIMA, SO THAT TINGO MARIA LEARNED ABOUT SUCH INCIDENTS FROM LIMA. GONZALES SAID HE KNEW ONLY ABOUT HELICOPTERS BEING USED TO TRANSPORT MEN AND MATERIALS. HE RECOMMENDED TALKING DIRECTLY WITH LT. COL. JAVIER RIVAS, COMANDANTE OF BCS (COUNTER-INSURGENCY BATTALLION) 313, AT THE LOS

8. BOTH GONZALES AND A SECOND PROSECUTOR, SENEN L. RAMOS GILES, SPOKE OF NUMEROUS ATROCITIES COMMITTED BY SENDERO, AND EXPRESSED THEIR BELIEF THAT ANY CIVILIAN DEATHS OCCURRING THESE DAYS WERE INDIVIDUAL INCIDENTS CAUSED BY NERVOUS SOLDIERS, RATHER THAN THE RESULT OF "STANDING ORDERS TO KILL AND INJURE SUCH AS THOSE IN EFFECT UNTIL 1992." THEY BOTH STRONGLY ENDORSED THE PACIFICATION PROGRAM. RAMOS BELIEVES THAT THE PROBLEM IS POOR INTELLIGENCE, SO THAT THE ARMY FINDS SENDERO WHEN IT IS IN VILLAGES, RATHER THAN IN COLUMNS. THEY BELIEVE SENDERO IS LOSING DRASTIC NUMBERS OF RANK AND FILE, WHO ARE REPENTING. HOWEVER, FORMER SENDERISTAS ARE CREATING OTHER PROBLEMS, BLACKMAILING THOSE THEY KNOW TO BE CURRENT OR FORMER GUERRILLAS. OTHER CRIMES ARE UP AS WELL, AS SENDERISTAS REENTER THE CIVILIAN POPULATION.

11. [REDACTED] ALSO SAID THERE WAS MUCH CORRUPTION IN THE MILITARY, AND REFERRED PARTICULARLY TO THE KILLING OF NARCOTRAFFICKERS FOR THEIR MONEY OR DRUGS.
