PROSELYTISM AND "SUPPORT OF SUBVERSION." HE COMPLAINED THAT THE WORK OF NGO'S IN SOME CASES WAS NOT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE WORK OF THE GOVERNMENT AND ASSERTED THAT NGO'S SHOULD "ADAPT TO THE GOVERNMENT'S POLICIES." NEITHER SOLARI NOR ZAMATTA WOULD PUBLICLY IDENTIFY ANY NGO'S SUSPECTED OF HAVING LINKS TO TERRORIST GROUPS.


- 2. ROSA MUJICA, EXECUTIVE SECRETARY OF THE NATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS COORDINATING COMMITTEE (COORDINADORA), TOLD POLOFF MAY 4 THAT SHE WAS UNCONCERNED ABOUT THE REMARKS. "THE GOVERNMENT ALREADY REGULATES NGO'S," SHE NOTED, ADDING, "THEY CANNOT TELL US HOW TO CARRY OUT OUR WORK." THE LATEST ATTACKS MAY WELL BE IN RESPONSE TO ACCUSATIONS BY HUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS THAT THE ARMY KILLED CIVILIAN NON-COMBATANTS IN HUANUCO DURING THE MILITARY COMMANDER OF THE HUALLAGA FRONT, ARMY GENERAL ALFREDO RODRIGUEZ, HINTED TO THE PRESS THAT THE ICRC MIGHT BE COLLABORATING WITH SENDERO LUMINOSO (REF B). THE FUJIMORI GOVERNMENT AND THE PRO-FUJIMORI PRESS HAVE ON A NUMBER OF OCCASIONS RESORTED TO TRYING TO DISCREDIT HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS AS A WAY OF DISMISSING ALLEGATIONS OF ABUSES. **ADAMS**
