GUARANTOR ARCHBISHOP CIPRIANI ANNOUNCED THAT THE EXCHANGE WAS  
CORDIAL BUT THAT THE TWO SIDES DID NOT AGREE ON SOME ISSUES. HE  
ADDED THAT A "REFLECTION PHASE" WAS NECESSARY, AND THE GUARANTORS  
WOULD BE MEETING WITH BOTH SIDES SEPARATELY IN AN EFFORT TO FIND  
A VIABLE SOLUTION. CIPRIANI SAID THE GUARANTORS WOULD ANNOUNCE

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CIPRIANI ANNOUNCED THE RESUMPTION OF THE TALKS MID-DAY MARCH 12. THE GUARANTORS HAD HELD MEETINGS WITH GOVERNMENT INTERLOCUTOR DOMINGO PALERMO MARCH 11 AND WITH MRTA LEADER NESTOR CERPA MARCH 12 IN A SUCCESSFUL EFFORT TO RESTART THE TALKS.

4. (U) GOVERNMENT INTERLOCUTOR PALERMO AND MRTA LEADER CERPA PARTICIPATED IN THE MARCH 12 TALKS. FOR THE FIRST TIME PALERMO WAS ACCOMPANIED BY DEPUTY HEALTH MINISTER ALEJANDRO AGUINAGA. AFTER THE TALKS, CIPRIANI READ A STATEMENT INDICATING THAT THE MEETING WAS CONDUCTED IN A CORDIAL FASHION AND THAT THE TWO PARTIES HAD RECEIVED THE PROPOSALS OF THE OTHER. (COMMENT: THE

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PROPOSALS OF EACH SIDE FOR THE RESOLVING THE CRISIS HAD BEEN GIVEN TO THE GUARANTORS AT THE NINTH ROUND ON MARCH 5. THE GUARANTORS ARE REPORTEDLY WORKING ON A PAPER SYNTHESIZING THE POSITIONS OF EACH SIDE; APPARENTLY THEY HAVE DECIDED TO DISCUSS THIS SEPARATELY BEFORE RECONVENING THE FULL CONTINGENT. END COMMENT.) CIPRIANI ADDED THAT THERE WAS NO AGREEMENT ON SOME ISSUES AND THAT A "REFLECTION PHASE" WAS NECESSARY. THE TALKS WOULD CONTINUE THROUGH SEPARATE MEETINGS IN WHICH THE GUARANTORS WOULD BE FACILITATING ALTERNATIVES IN ORDER TO ARRIVE AT A VIABLE SOLUTION. CIPRIANI CONCLUDED BY SAYING THE GUARANTORS WOULD ANNOUNCE THE NEXT JOINT MEETING AT A LATER DATE.

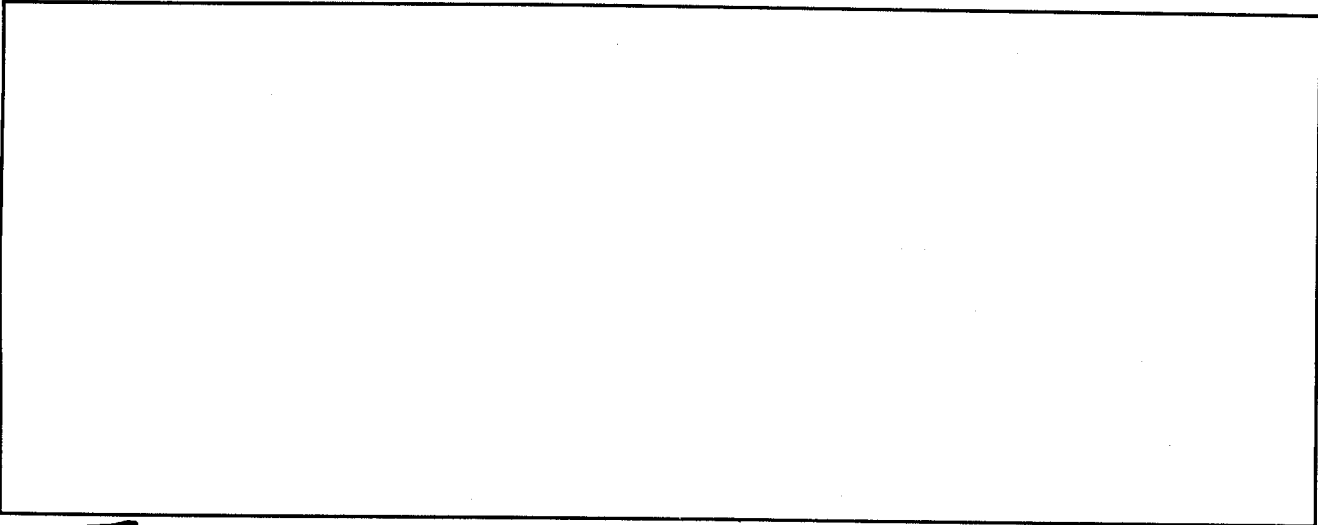

7. [REDACTED] SAID THAT MRTA LEADER CERPA FELT THE GOVERNMENT'S SUSPENSION OF THE TALKS HELPED THE MRTA SINCE IT SHOWED THE GOVERNMENT IN A BAD LIGHT. THE TERRORIST LEADER NOTED THAT THE MRTA WAS NOT IN A RUSH AND APPEARED READY TO WAIT AS LONG AS NECESSARY. REGARDING CERPA, [REDACTED] DESCRIBED HIM AS HAVING "TUNNEL VISION" AND POINTED OUT THAT CERPA HAD NOT CHANGED HIS WAY OF THINKING MUCH SINCE HIS INVOLVEMENT IN THE 1978-79 CROMOTEX FACTORY TAKEOVER (WHICH ENDED IN A VIOLENT FASHION). [REDACTED] NOTED THAT THE MRTA LEADERS BELIEVE THEY WILL BE ABLE TO GET SOME SICK MRTA PRISONERS RELEASED. WHILE SOME OF THE MRTA HOSTAGE TAKERS REMAIN OPTIMISTIC ABOUT THE FINAL OUTCOME, [REDACTED] NOTED THAT SOME WERE BECOMING PESSIMISTIC. AS HE HAS IN PREVIOUS MEETINGS, [REDACTED] CRITICIZED THE GOVERNMENT FOR ALLOWING A DAY OR TWO TO PASS BETWEEN THE SESSIONS, BECAUSE HE SAID THIS PERMITTED THE MRTA HARDLINERS TIME TO CONVINCING THE OTHERS AGAINST TAKING A MODERATE APPROACH. HE EXPLAINED THAT THE HOSTAGE TAKERS ARE NOT "POLITICIANS." EVEN SO, [REDACTED] EXPRESSED SURPRISE AT HOW UNITED THE MRTA HOSTAGE TAKERS STILL ARE. THE FOUR MRTA LEADERS CONTINUE TO TRAIN THE YOUNGER HOSTAGE TAKERS. AS FOR "TITO," THE INJURED MRTA HOSTAGE TAKER, [REDACTED]

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RESIDENCE, [REDACTED] SAID THERE HAD BEEN TENSION BETWEEN THE HOSTAGES AND THE MRTA FOR SEVERAL DAYS AFTER THE MRTA ANNOUNCED THEY WERE SUSPENDING THE TALKS, AND SOME HOSTAGES HAVE BEEN LESS TALKATIVE WITH THE MRTA THAN BEFORE, BUT THE SITUATION INSIDE HAD NOW COOLED DOWN AND THE TWO SIDES WERE MORE OR LESS BACK TO NORMAL. [REDACTED] BELIEVES THAT SOME HOSTAGES HAVE NOW RESIGNED THEMSELVES TO THE LIKELIHOOD OF A VIOLENT END TO THE CRISIS. HE ALSO SAID SOME HOSTAGES MAY BE CONSIDERING TAKING MATTERS INTO THEIR HANDS; HE EXPLAINED THAT THIS WAS NOT, HOWEVER, BEING CONSIDERED BY THE MILITARY OR POLICE PERSONNEL WHO WERE HOSTAGES. ALL THE HOSTAGES ARE NOW HOUSED ON THE SECOND FLOOR AND GO TO THE FIRST FLOOR IN CONTROLLED GROUPS TO RECEIVE THE ICRC MEDICAL TREATMENT OR MEDICINES. AS FAR AS [REDACTED] KNOWS, NONE OF THE HOSTAGES HAVE "BONDED" WITH ANY OF THE MRTA HOSTAGE TAKERS.

[REDACTED] SAID THE HUNGER STRIKE WAS CAUSED BY THE FACT THE FEMALE MRTA DETAINEES HAD NOT BEEN ABLE TO SEE THEIR CHILDREN SINCE SEPTEMBER. THEY WERE SCHEDULED TO SEE THE CHILDREN AT CHRISTMASTIME, BUT THIS VISIT WAS CANCELED DUE TO THE GOVERNMENT-IMPOSED SUSPENSION OF FAMILY VISITS CAUSED BY THE MRTA HOSTAGE TAKEOVER. (NOTE: VISITS BY CHILDREN OF TERRORISM DETAINEES WERE PERMITTED BEFORE THE HOSTAGE CRISIS ONLY ONCE EVERY THREE MONTHS. END NOTE.) [REDACTED] SAID BELGIAN PRISON CHAPLAIN FATHER LANSSIERS HAD RECENTLY VISITED THE HUNGER STRIKERS, BUT DID NOT REVEAL [REDACTED] MUCH ABOUT THEIR SITUATION EXCEPT THAT THEY WERE NOT IN GOOD CONDITION. 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10. [REDACTED] NOTED THAT THE MRTA AND THE HOSTAGES WERE RUNNING LOW ON BATTERIES. TWO MONTHS AGO, THE GOVERNMENT HAD PROVIDED BATTERIES TO THE RESIDENCE FOR USE BY THE HOSTAGES WITH SIX CD PLAYERS, BUT THE MRTA HAD TAKEN MOST OF THE BATTERIES AND USED THEM TO POWER ITS RADIOS FOR OUTSIDE COMMUNICATION. THE HOSTAGES USE THE BATTERIES TO LISTEN TO RADIO PROGRAMS AND DO NOT USE THE CD PLAYERS MUCH BECAUSE THEY RUN OUT OF BATTERIES VERY QUICKLY. SO FAR NEITHER THE MRTA NOR THE HOSTAGES HAVE ASKED FOR NEW BATTERIES. THUS, ONCE THE BATTERIES RUN OUT BOTH THE MRTA AND THE HOSTAGES WILL BE CUT OFF FROM OUTSIDE INFORMATION. THE ICRC DOES NOT TAKE NEWSPAPERS INSIDE THE RESIDENCE, EXCEPT FOR THE SPORTS PAGES, AND HAS BEEN REGULARLY PROVIDING BOOKS TO THE HOSTAGES.

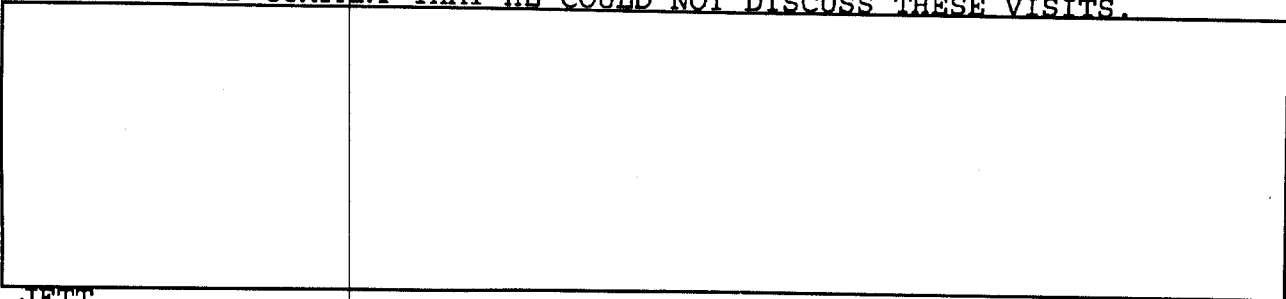

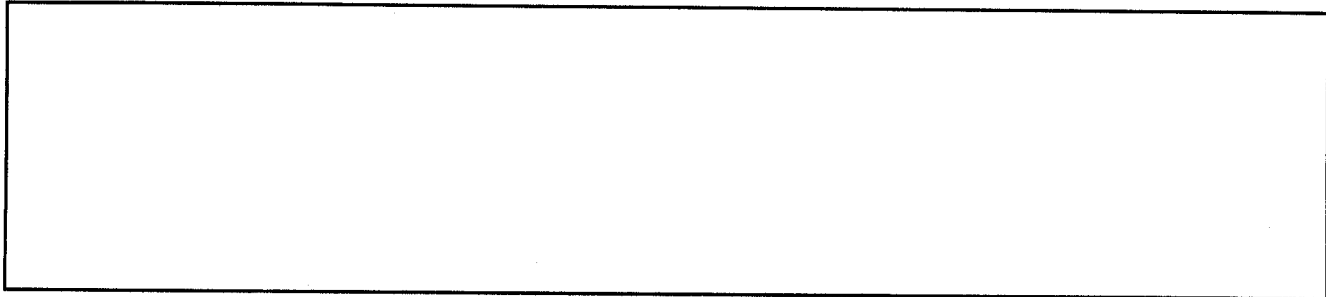

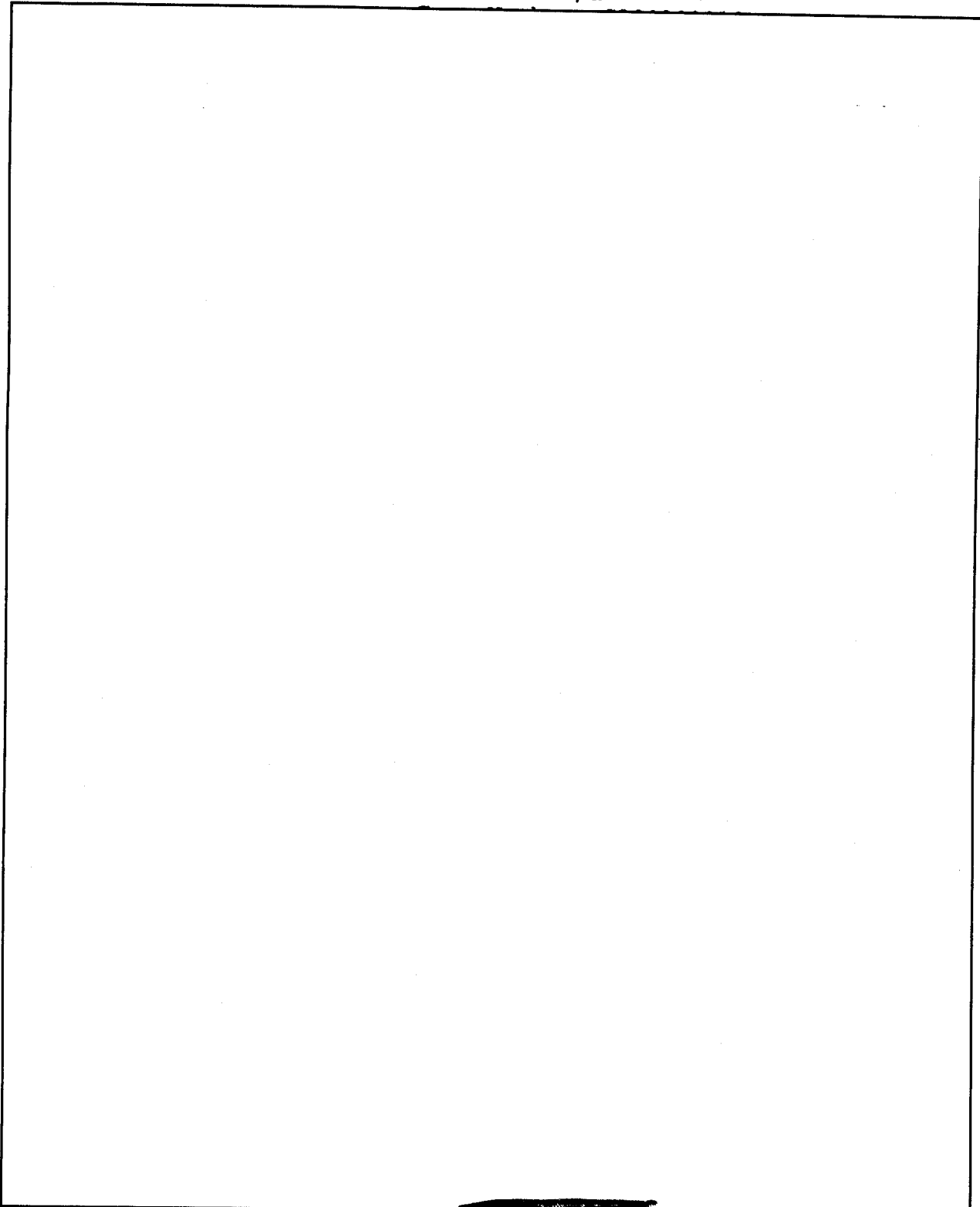
