2. SUMMARY:

EXPECTS HARSH SENTENCES AND NO PARDONS FOR RINGLEADERS OF THE NOVEMBER 13 COUP. HE SAW NO EARLY HOPE FOR ECONOMIC RECOVERY, EXPECTING THE CAPITAL REPATRIATION PROCESS TO REQUIRE DECADES OF CONFIDENCE BUILDING BEFORE IT OCCURS.
