1. IN THIRD MONTH OF MILITARY OCCUPATION OF UPPER HUALLAGA AREA, COCA ERADICATION CONTINUED WITHOUT UMOPAR PROTECTION. INTERDICTION OF NARCOTICS TRAFFIC AND SEIZURES REMAINED AT LOW LEVEL BECAUSE OF RELUCTANCE OF MILITARY COMMAND TO ALLOW UMOPAR TO FUNCTION NORMALLY. EMBASSY HAS CONTINUED TO PRESS AT ALL LEVELS FOR UMOPAR TO BE ALLOWED TO RESUME NORMAL FUNCTIONS. GUERRILLA ACTIVITY IN AREA HAS BEEN REDUCED TO ALMOST NOTHING SINCE BEGINNING OF MILITARY LIMITED OFFICIAL USE

OCCUPATION, ALTHOUGH TRAFFICKER VIOLENCE CONTINUES.

2. AS AN EXAMPLE OF VIOLENCE MENTIONED ABOVE, TWO BANDS OF COLOMBIAN-PERUVIAN TRAFFICKERS APPARENTLY ENGAGED IN VIOLENT CONFRONTATION ON OCTOBER 18 NEAR VILLAGE OF CACHICOTO, SOME THIRTY KM. NORTH OF TINGO MARIA. BOTH BANDS WERE APPARENTLY HEAVILY ARMED WITH AUTOMATIC WEAPONS. ALTHOUGH EXACT DETAILS OF THE ENCOUNTER ARE UNKNOWN, SEVENTEEN BODIES WERE FOUND FLOATING IN RIVER BY LOCAL

IN SERIES OF OPERATIONS CODENAMED "PIHUICHO" AND "PICURO", PIP AGENTS NEAR JUANJUI, IN SAN MARTIN DEPARTMENT, ARRESTED FIVE PERSONS, DESTROYED TWO MACERATION LABS AND SEIZED AN UNDETERMINED AMOUNT OF ARMS AND COCA PASTE BETWEEN OCTOBER 26 AND NOVEMBER 3. TWO OF ARRESTEES WERE CHARACTERIZED AS EMPLOYERS OF TAXI AEREO SELVA (TAS). SMALL CARGO AIRLINE OPERATING IN PERU, COLOMBIA AND BRASIL WHICH HAS LONG BEEN SUSPECTED OF TRAFFICKER CONNECTIONS.

10. UPPER HUALLAGA (CORAH) PROJECT NO. 313601-0104  
COCA ERADICATION FOR STATISTICS WERE LESS THAN HOPED IN  
OCTOBER, MOSTLY DUE TO LACK OF POLICE PROTECTION NOTED  
ABOVE, WHICH FORCED CORAH WORKERS TO BEGIN WORK A LITTLE  
LATER AND END A LITTLE EARLIER IN ORDER TO UTILIZE DAYLIGHT  
HOURS AND AVOID OPTIMUM AMBUSH CONDITIONS. STILL, ERA-

DICATION FIGURE FOR OCTOBER SHOWED 550 HECTARES, BEST SINGLE MONTH IN LIFE OF PROJECT TO DATE. THIS RAISES TOTAL FOR 1984 TO 2930 HECTARES AND FOR LIFE OF PROJECT TO 3763 HECTARES.

THE POSITION HAS BEEN VACANT SINCE THE DEPARTURE OF JOHN CASWELL IN JUNE. AFTER A SCHEDULED THREE-WEEK TDY IN LIMA DURING OCTOBER, MR. CROW RETURNED TO BOGOTA AND IS EXPECTED IN LIMA BY LATE DECEMBER. AMEMBASSY LIMA WELCOMES MR. CROW AND IS HAPPY TO HAVE HIM ONBOARD.

13. FIRST ANNUAL PERUVIAN DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION CONFERENCE, ORGANIZED BY USIS LIMA, TOOK PLACE AT THE PERUVIAN-AMERICAN CULTURAL CENTER IN LIMA OCTOBER 29-31. ORIGINALLY INTENDED AS A SMALL NARCOTICS AWARENESS SEMINAR FOR LOCAL JOURNALISTS, THE IDEA CAUGHT ON AND EXPANDED, AND CONFERENCE EVENTUALLY PLAYED HOST TO OVER 300 REPRESENTATIVES OF GOP, PRESS, MEDICAL AND EDUCATIONAL PROFESSIONS, POLICE AND MILITARY SERVICES, AND LEADERS OF PARENT AND YOUTH GROUPS. OPENING CEREMONIES WERE ADDRESSED BY DCM OGDEN AND MINISTER OF HEALTH JUAN FRANCO, CLOSING BY PRESIDENT BELAUDE, AMBASSADOR JORDAN AND MINISTER OF EDUCATION ANDRES CARDO. IN BETWEEN, AUDIENCE RECEIVED PRESENTATIONS ON VARIOUS ASPECTS OF DRUG ADDICTION PROBLEM FROM WIDELY-KNOWN EXPERTS SUCH AS DR. RAUL JERI, DR. ETHEL BAZAN, AND MANUEL GALLARDO OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE. A PRESENTATION BY COLOMBIAN EXPERT DR. MARIA SALAZAR DE LINCE WAS WELL-RECEIVED. CONFERENCE WAS WIDELY COVERED IN VIRTUALLY ALL SEGMENTS OF PRESS AND ATTRACTED FAVORABLE EDITORIAL COMMENT.

14. IN RESPONSE TO CRITICS OF COCA ERADICATION PROGRAM, DR. JUAN DE MADALENGOITIA, HEAD OF NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTE, URGED FARMERS GROWING COCA TO CONSIDER REPLACING IT WITH OTHER CROPS, POINTING OUT PLAN OF NARANJILLO COOPERATIVE TO CULTIVATE CACAO IN UPPER HUALLAGA AS MODEL

FOR OTHERS TO FOLLOW. STATEMENT WAS MADE AT PRESS CON-  
FERENCE CALLED TO ANNOUNCE UNFDAC GRANT OF \$1 MILLION TO  
NARANJILLO COOPERATIVE TO IMPLEMENT ITS PROGRAM, AND WAS  
CITED BY MADALENGOITIA AS PROOF THAT UN AND INDUSTRIAL  
COUNTRIES WILL HELP PERUVIANS IN SWITCHING TO CROPS WHICH  
ARE BOTH LEGAL AND PROFITABLE. JORDAN
