- 1. Q.OU) AS PART OF ITS BUILDUP OF FORCES IN THE AYACUCHO AREA, THE GOP SENT ANOTHER 120-150 ARMY TROOPS TO THAT CITY ON DECEMBER 27. THE UNITS ARE REPORTEDLY LOGISTICAL, COMMUNICATIONS, AND INTELLIGENCE SPECIALISTS. THIS BRINGS THE FORL HE TROOPS IN THE AREA TO APPROXIMATELY 558. LIMA DAILY "EL GESERVADOR" REPORTED ON DECEMBER 28 THAT THE TOTAL MILITARY STRENGTH IN AYACUCHO LINCLUDING THE LOS CABITOS GARRISON) IS NOW AT 1,500. REPORTS FROM AYACUCHO ASSERT THAT ARMY TROOPS LEFT THE CITY ON DECEMBER 27, BOUND FOR CAMBALLO AND VICTOR FAJARDO PROVINCES TO THE SOUTH. THESE THO PROVINCES ARE CONSIDERED CENTERS OF SENDERO LUNINOSO CONTROL.
- 2. (C) EMBASSY DAO IS FORWARDING SEPARATELY A COPY OF THE PERUVIAN ARMY'S "DOCTRIME ON INTERNAL DEFENSE".

 OIT) WHICK IS TAUGHT TO SECOND-YEAR WAR COLLEGE STUDENTS. THE ACTIONS OF THE GOP, INCLUDING THE CURRENT TROOP. HOVENENTS, TRACK WERY CLOSELY WITH THIS DOCTRIME. ACCORDING TO THE DIT, THE FIRST PHASE OF DEFENSE AGAINST CIVIL INSURRECTION IS PREVENTATIVE AND IS UNDER THE CONTROL OF POLICE AUTHORITIES. IF THE PREVENTATIVE FAILS TO RESTROE ORDER IN THE AFFECTED AREA, THE PLAN CALLS FOR A "REPRESSIVE" PHASE UNDER A STATE OF EMERGENCY OR STATE OF SIEGE. IN THE REPRESSIVE STAGE THE MILITARY ASSUMES POLITICAL-HILITARY CONTROL OF THE AREA AND TAKES "DECISIVE, FORCEFUL ACTION" TO RESTORE ORDER.
- 3. Q.OU) THE NEWS OF THE ARMY BUILDUP IN AYACUCRO WAS WELL-RECEIVED BY VIRTUALLY ALL PUBLIC FIGURES OUTSIDE OF THE MARXIST LEFT. HARXIST LINA DAILY "DIARIO DE MARKA" EDITORIALIZED ON DECEMBER 28 THAT ARMY INTERVENTION IN THE ANTI-TERRORIST CAMPAIGN WOULD LEAD TO THE DEATHS OF INHOCENT CIVILIAUS AND THAT THE "PEOPLE" WOULD BE THE VICTIMS OF THE INTERVENTION. "DIARIO" ALSO RAN AN "EXCLUSIVE" CLAIMING THAT SL HAD SPURNED PRESIDENT BELAUNDE'S CALL FOR A SURRENDER (REF B) AND VOWED TO MEET "REPRESSION" WITH "MORE GUERRILLA ACTIONS."
- 4. (U) TERRORIST UPDATE: ON DECEMBER 27, AT 7:15 PM, THREE HEN ARMED WITH A SUBMACHINEGUM ATTACKED AND KILLED THE CIVIL GUARD POSTED AT THE MONTERICO RESIDENCE OF INTERIOR VICE MINISTER HECTOR LOPEZ

MARTINEZ. AFTER KILLING THE POLICE OFFICER, THE ATTACKERS TOOM HIS SUBMACHINEGUN AND PISTOL AND FLEC FROM THE LINA SUBURB IN TWO CARS. POLICE CALLED THE KILLING THE WORN OF COMMON CRIMINALS BUT DID NOT DISCOUNT THE POSSIBILITY THAT IT WAS A TERRORIST ATTACK. SOFE LINA DAILIES REPORTED IT AS SUCH.

(U) OUTSIDE OF LIMA, ARNED HEN ATTACKED THE MACHENTE BRANCH OF THE NATIONAL BANK (BANCO DE LA NACION), 1K THE EARLY HOURS OF THE 27TH, AND SET FIRE TO ITS CONTENTS. THE MAYOR OF THE SAME TOWN - 1150 KILOMETERS FROM AYACUCHO CITY) WAS KILLED BY TERRORISTS ON DECEMBER 25. ALSC ON DECEMBER 27, IN LA MAR PROVINCE'S SAN HIGUEL, TERRORISTS DYNAMITED A WATER CONDUIT FOR THE LOCAL HYDRO-ELECTRIC PLANT, MNOCKING OUT THE AREA'S ELECTRICAL SUPPLY. THE CIVIL GUARD ICGI IN AYACUCHO REPORTED AN ATTACK OH ITS POST AT HUANCAPI IN VICTOR FAJARDO ON THE HORNING OF THE 27TH, PRIOR TO THE TROOP HOVEMENTS AND CLAIMED ONLY ONE GC WAS WOUNDED IN THE SUCCESSFUL DEFENSE OF THE POST. TRAVELERS FROM AVACUCHO. INTERVIEWED AT LIMA'S AIRPORT, SAID THAT THE CITY ITSELF WAS CALH AND ONE NOTED THAT THE OUTSKIRTS OF THE CITY WERE HEAVILY GUARDED BY ARMY AIRBORNE (AERO-TRANSPORTADA) TROOPS. ORT 12
