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PROGRAM FOR BUDGETARY SUPPORT FOR FY-86. WE HAVE ALSO RECOMMENDED BEGINNING A SMALL (\$3 MILLION) MAP PROGRAM. THESE RECOMMENDATIONS, HOWEVER, HAVE A NUMBER OF HURDLES TO OVERCOME BEFORE THEY ACTUALLY BECOME A PART OF THE PRESIDENT'S BUDGET REQUEST.

4. WE SEE NO DIFFICULTY WITH MAINTAINING A CONTINUITY LEVEL ON IMET. HOWEVER, AS HAS BEEN NOTED IN 83 STATE 349736 AND IN CHAPTER 10 OF THE SECURITY ASSISTANCE MANAGEMENT MANUAL (SAM), WE DO NOT BELIEVE OTTS SERVE THE LONG-TERM OBJECTIVES OF THE IMET PROGRAM. EMPHASIS SHOULD BE ON LONGER TERM TRAINING IN CONUS. THE NUMBER OF OTTS AND THE AMOUNT OF PERSONNEL COMPRISING EACH TOUR SHOULD BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM SINCE THEY ARE EXPENSIVE IN TERMS OF US SERVICE SUPPORT PERSONNEL AND IMET FUNDS. THUS TOURS SHOULD NOT COMPRISE A MAJOR PORTION OF AN ESTABLISHED PROGRAM NOR BE A ROUTINE USE OF COUNTRY PROGRAM FUNDS. DAM

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
