THE PERUVIAN COUNCIL OF MINISTERS VOTED SEPTEMBER 9 TO RENEW FOR SIXTY DAYS THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN EFFECT IN THE AYACUICHO PROVINCES OF LA MAR AND CANUALLO, AND THE APURIMAC PROVINCE OF ANDAHUAYLAS, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 10. AS BEFORE, THE DECREE CHARGED THE INTERIOR MINISTRY (I.E., THE POLICE) WITH IMPLEMENTATION.
2. OTHER PROVINCES WHERE A STATE OF EMERGENCY IS CURRENTLY IN EFFECT ARE: VICTOR FAJARDO (DEPARTMENT OF AYACUCHO), TO EXPIRE SEPTEMBER 14; LIMA (DEPARTMENT OF LIMA), TO EXPIRE OCTOBER 18; CONSTITUTIONAL PROVINCES OF CALLAO, TO EXPIRE OCTOBER 18.
